Aggie License Plate Program Supports Scholarships

Show your Aggie Pride and support students while you drive. Participating in the Alumni Association's Aggie License Plate Program is a great way to show everyone you are an Aggie while helping students from your area go to Utah State.

Every year, alumni chapters give out scholarships to incoming freshman who are children or grandchildren of Aggie alumni. These chapter scholarships, known as Alumni Legacy Scholarships, are primarily funded by this license plate program.

Receiving Aggie plates is easy. Simply take in your vehicle registration to any DMV office and request the Aggie plates. You can request them online at https://mva.usu.edu/script_local/license.html as well. In addition, many car dealerships can request the plates for you when registering your new vehicle.

The cost is \$25 per year which will automatically be

added to your registration renewal in the form of a Collegiate License Plate Fee. Of the \$25 donation, \$15 goes to the chapter in which your car is registered, \$5 goes toward the general scholarship fund, and \$5 goes to the state for the printing and delivering of the plates. A one-time fee of \$10 is also charged upon acquiring the plates.
