APPLICATION MATERIALS AND DEADLINES

Return completed application (including portfolio) by February 1, 2010. Consideration is given only to fall semester applicants.

UTAH STATE UNIVERSITY AMBASSADORS

The Ambassador Scholarship is awarded annually to incoming freshmen and transfer students. The scholarship is awarded for up to eight semesters, provided a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and 24 credits per academic school year are maintained and the recipient participates in all ambassador functions as assigned by the Admissions Office. As an ambassador, students meet weekly to coordinate and perform recruitment activities. While on scholarship, ambassadors are asked to participate in a variety of recruitment events including high school visits, student host weekends, campus tours, and other recruitment programs. Additional participation in recruitment committees and campus involvement is encouraged.

University Ambassadors should be well-rounded individuals who have demonstrated ability in and outside the classroom and reflect the quality of students admitted to Utah State University. Because the primary function of the ambassador program is to assist future Utah State students, ambassadors should have strong interpersonal skills, the ability to work in team environments, and display enthusiasm for Utah State. Students who have demonstrated extensive high school involvement in extracurricular activities such as student government, club involvement, service coordination, and other significant leadership opportunities are encouraged to apply.

Your portfolio should convey your skills, experience, and assets to the Reviewing Committee. (Following a review of the portfolios, applicants may receive an invitation to interview and give a presentation to the scholarship selection committee.)

Your portfolio must include:

- 1 page application (on reverse side).
- 1 page cover letter indicating your desire and qualifications to be a Utah State University Ambassador
- 1 page resume of recruitment, leadership, and service experience
- 1 page of questionnaire completed - questionnaire form is included with application
- 2-4 pages of graphics, illustrations, pictures, accomplishments, etc. that convey who you are. Be creative; let us discover you!
Awards and pictures may be reduced to maximize space.
- 2 sealed letters of recommendation must accompany your portfolio. The Letter of Recommendation form is included with this application. (Recommendations are not included as part of the maximum 8 pages of portfolio.)

*** Portfolios must be submitted in a half-inch (8.5 X 11) three ring binder.***

REQUIREMENTS FOR FRESHMEN APPLICANTS

- The Ambassador Application must be postmarked by February 1, 2010, and mailed to the address on the application.
- A 108 index AND a minimum 21 ACT (or SAT of 980) are required.
Note: Eligibility requires both index and ACT/SAT parameters are met.
- The Application for Admissions & Scholarship (including application fee), an official high school transcript, and an official ACT/SAT score must be postmarked by February 1, 2010.
- Applicants agree to attend USU fall and spring semesters before requesting a hold on the scholarship.
Unless a hold is requested and approved (for military service, church service, or medical considerations), applicants agree to use the scholarship in consecutive semesters (summer excluded).
- A personal portfolio must accompany this application (see section above). Focus on high school years only.
- No application fee is required to apply for the Ambassador Scholarship; \$10.00 is required for your portfolio to be returned.
- 2010 high school seniors are eligible to apply.

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER APPLICANTS

- The Ambassador Application must be postmarked by February 1, 2010, and mailed to the address on the application.
- A minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA and have or will earn a minimum 48 post-high school credit hours prior to fall 2010 semester.
- The Application for Admissions & Scholarship (including application fee) and official college/university transcript(s) must be submitted by February 1, 2010.
- Applicants agree to attend USU fall and spring semesters before requesting a hold on the scholarship.
Unless a hold is requested and approved (for military service, church service, or medical considerations), applicants agree to use the scholarship in consecutive semesters (summer excluded).
- A personal portfolio must accompany this application (see section above). Focus on high school and college years only.
- No application fee is required to apply for the Ambassador Scholarship; \$10.00 is required for your portfolio to be returned.
