

Utah State University is invested in its students' academic progress and wants to ensure that each readmitted student has the best opportunity for success. For that reason, USU admissions officials carefully review each application to determine a student's readiness to return. If you left Utah State University with a USU cumulative grade point average (GPA) of less than 2.0, then you must apply for readmission, and in addition, must complete the following steps:

1. Fill out an Undergraduate Readmission Application and an Academic Inquiry form. These forms can be found in the Admissions Office, TSC 102.
2. Attach a typewritten personal letter to these forms. The letter should explain: why you did not achieve academic good standing at USU; what you have been doing in your time away from USU that would enhance your academic performance; what major you would like to pursue upon readmission; how many semesters you estimate it will take you to graduate; and what in your life has changed that will help you to succeed at USU.
3. Submit your application, academic inquiry form, and personal letter to the Admissions Office, TSC 102.

Expected wait time for decisions made on readmission applications is three to four weeks. Utah State University Admissions representatives and other advisors make decisions based upon:

- A student's transcript
- Quality hours (QHRS)
- Attempted hours (AHRS)
- A student's personal letter
- And the number of semesters needed to return to academic good standing

In addition to these considerations, academic success at another institution will improve the prospects for readmission.
