- You will be notified of your acceptance once I deem you eligible for field school
- **When you are notified of your acceptance, you must remit a \$250 deposit to hold your place in the class.** Should you later decide not to attend field school, your deposit will be refunded if I can fill your slot. If I cannot, you will forfeit your deposit.
- If you are from another university, you must apply for admittance to USU before your deposit can be processed (don't worry; this doesn't mean you are transferring to USU; it's just how the admissions and registrar folks process non-USU participants so that you receive the credits you'll later transfer to your own school). Applying is easy to do, and I will help you with the process.
- Field school details will be finalized and distributed later this spring, but feel free to ask questions anytime.
