

USU Archaeology Internships for Native American High School Students

These internships offer opportunities for high school students from the Northwest Band of the Shoshone and the Northern Ute Tribe to participate in archaeological survey and excavation. The program consists of 3 field sessions, each lasting ten days. The first two sessions will be held in the Gunnison, Colorado area, and the third session will be held in Southeastern Idaho.
