

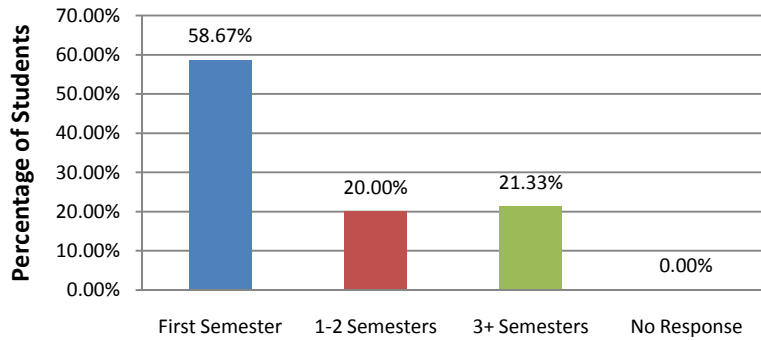

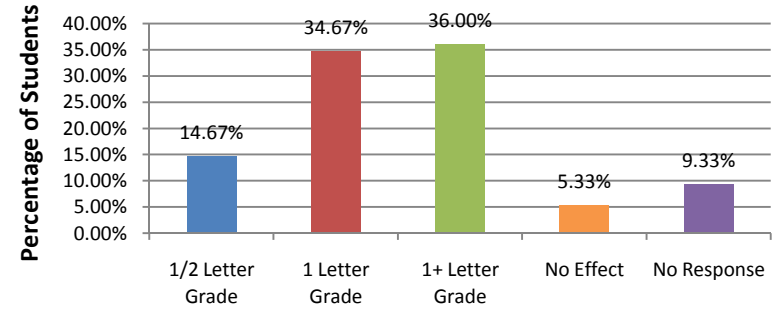

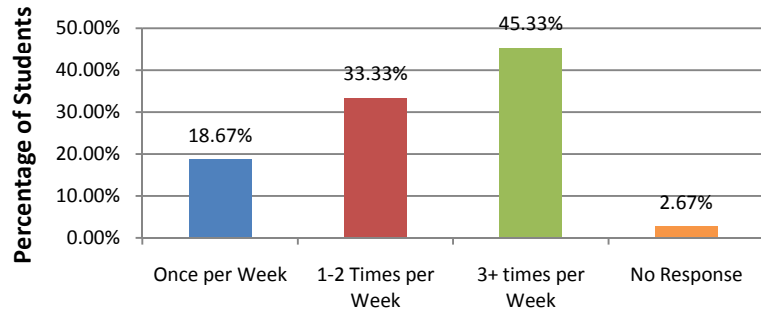
How long have you used drop-in tutoring?



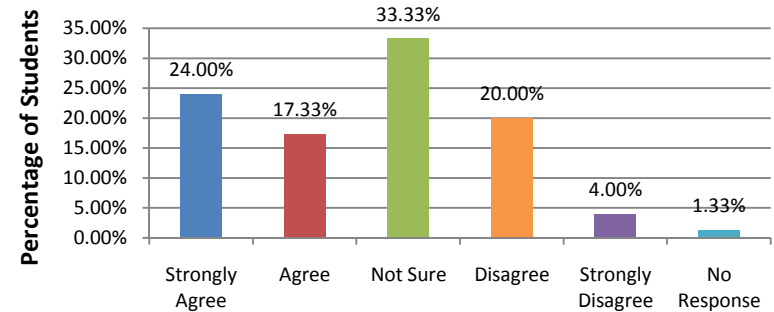
Tutoring helped improve my final course grade by:



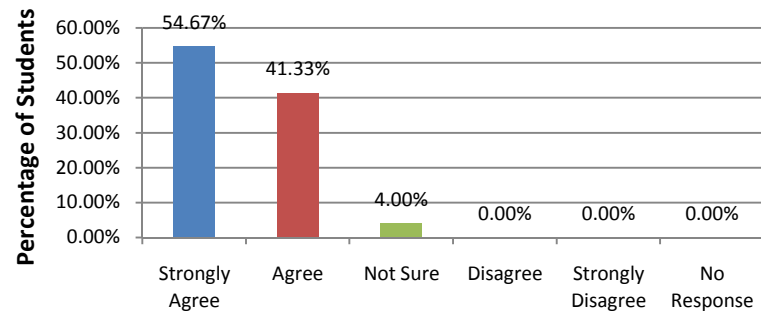
