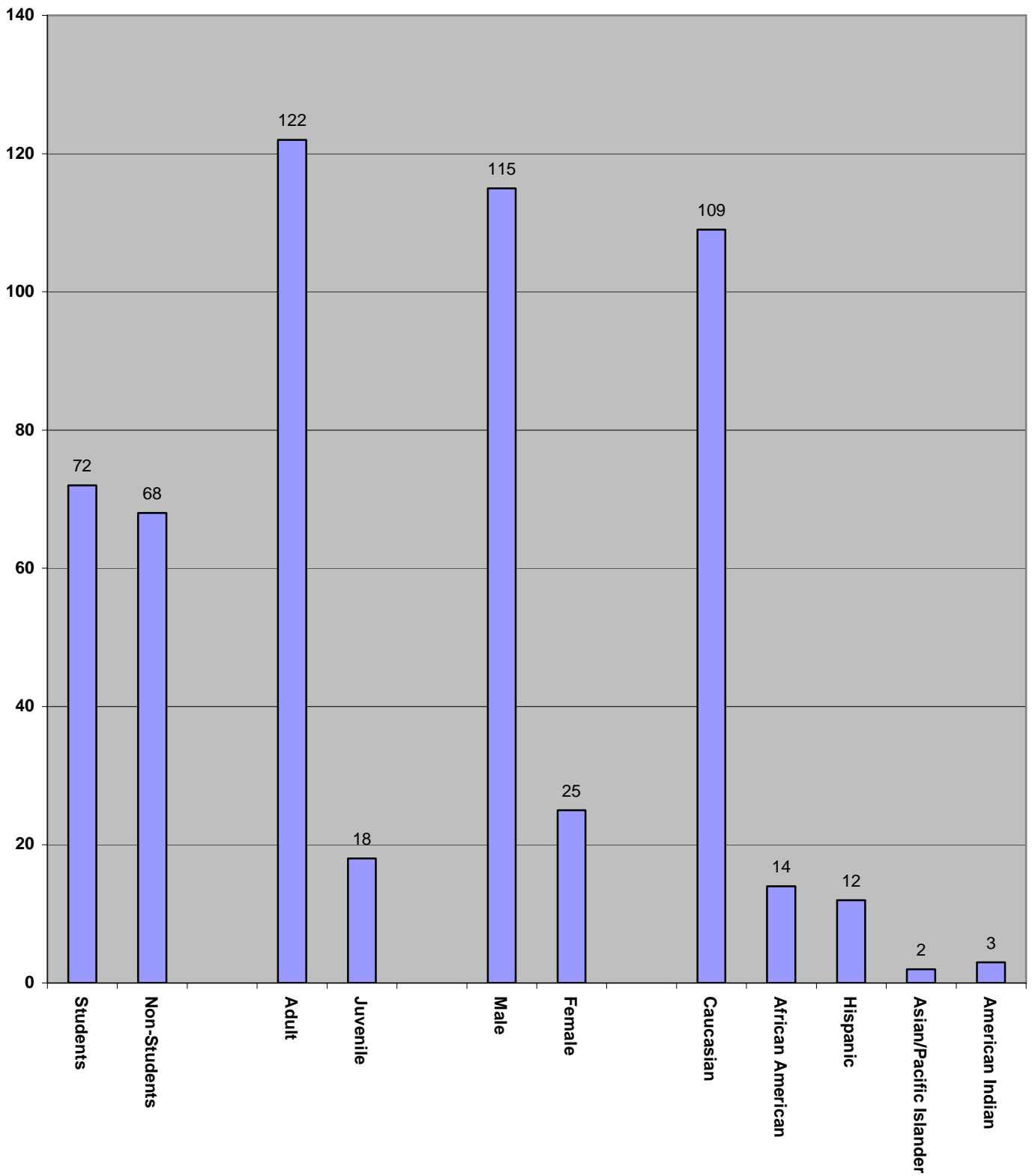

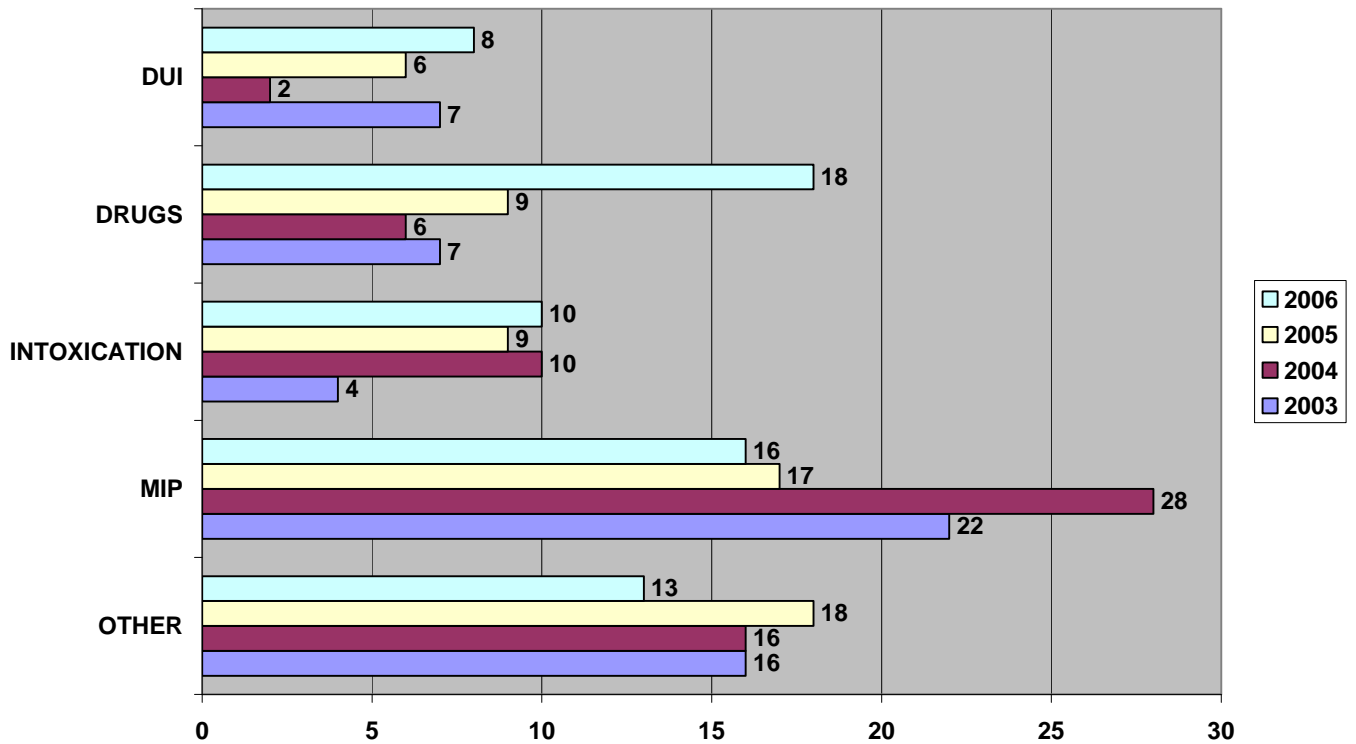

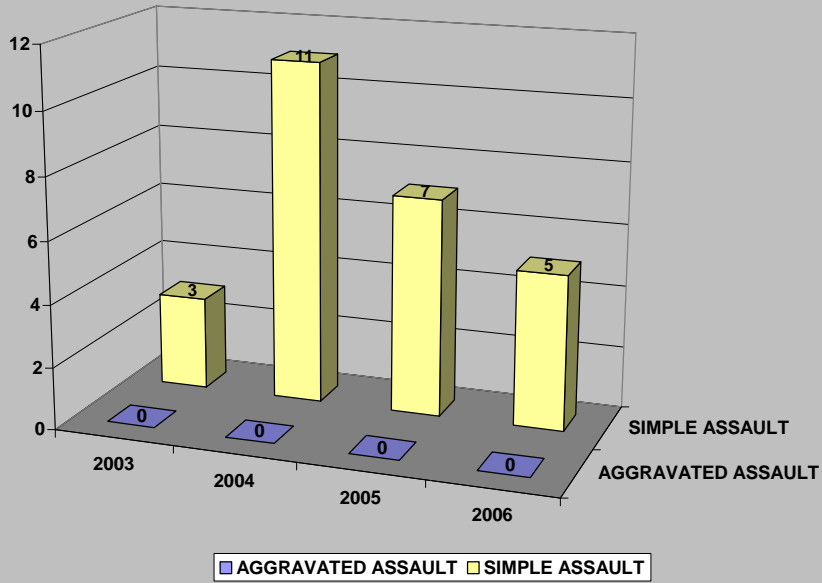
ALCOHOL AND DRUGS PER DAY OF THE WEEK



ALCOHOL AND DRUGS HOUR OF THE DAY

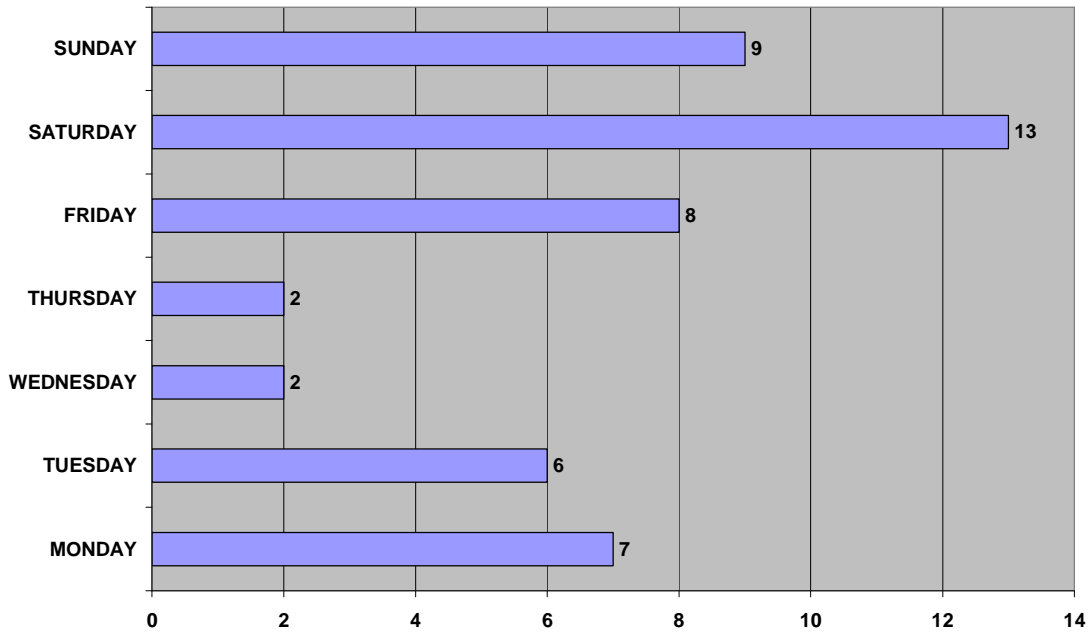

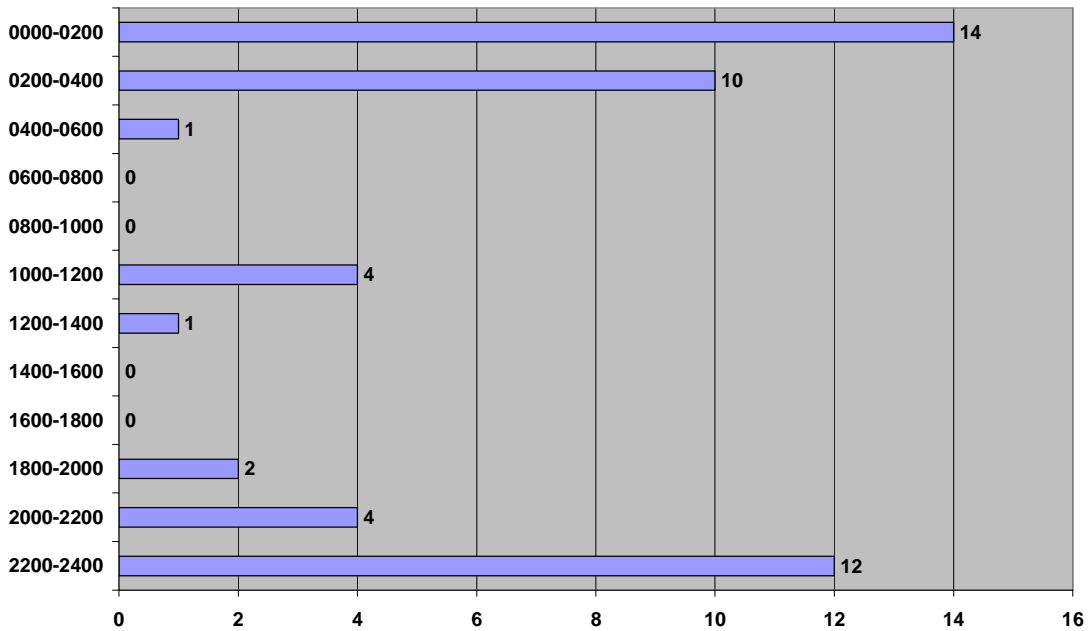

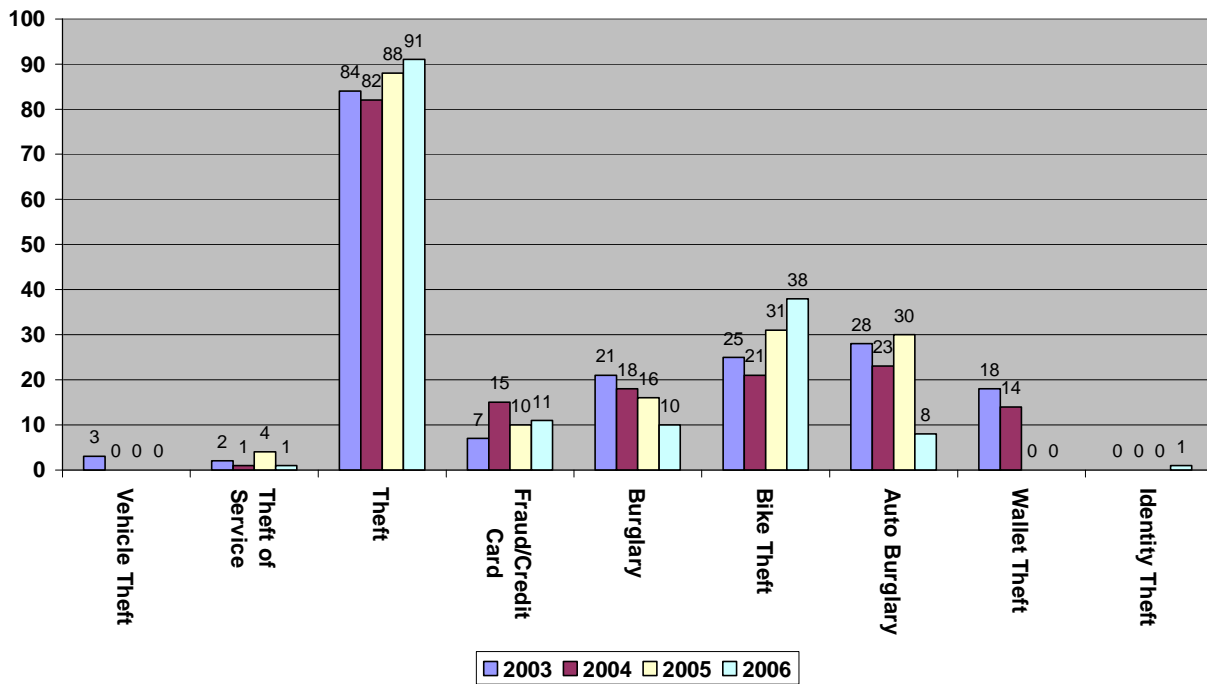

ASSAULTS PER HOUR OF THE DAY

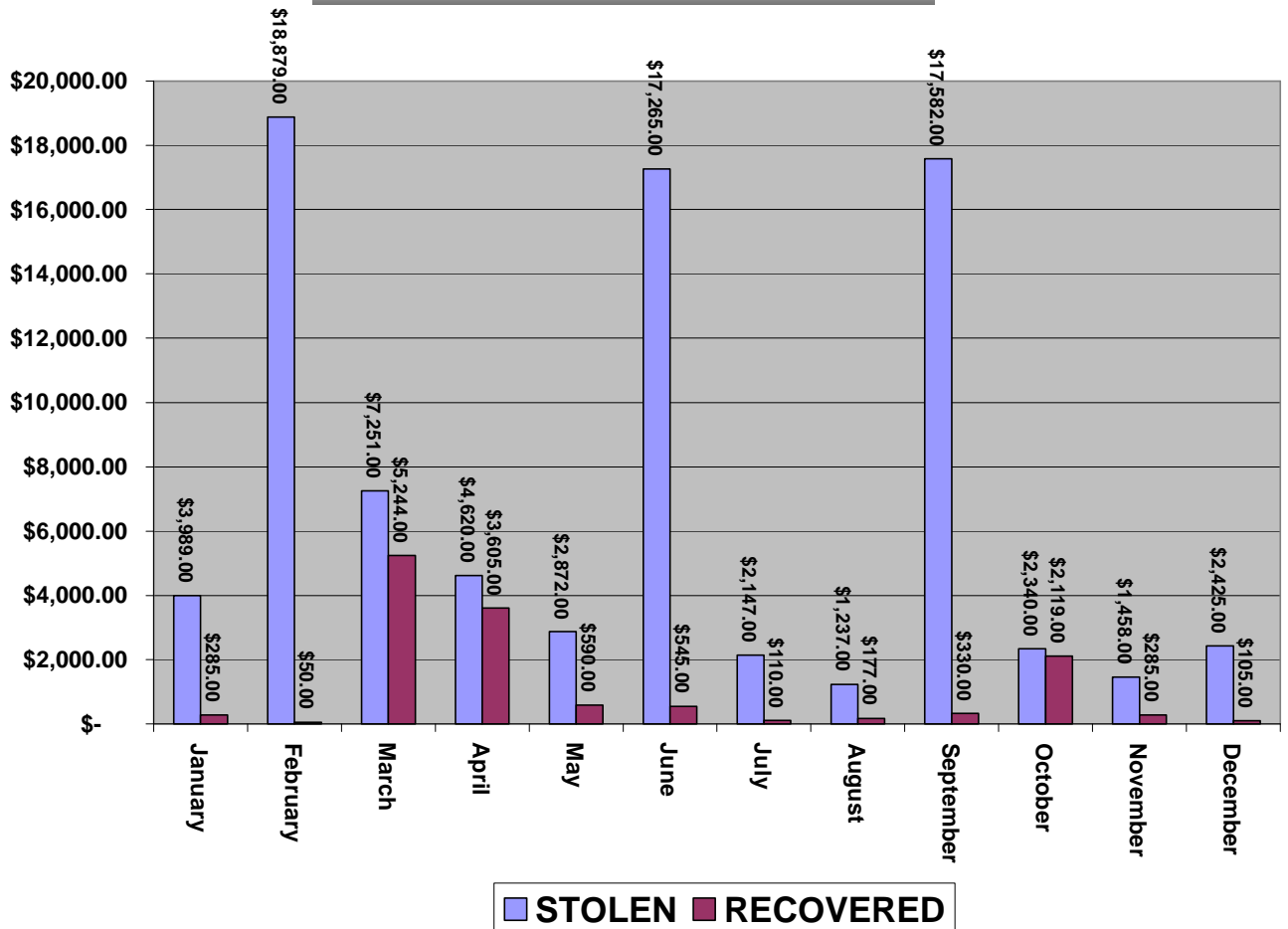

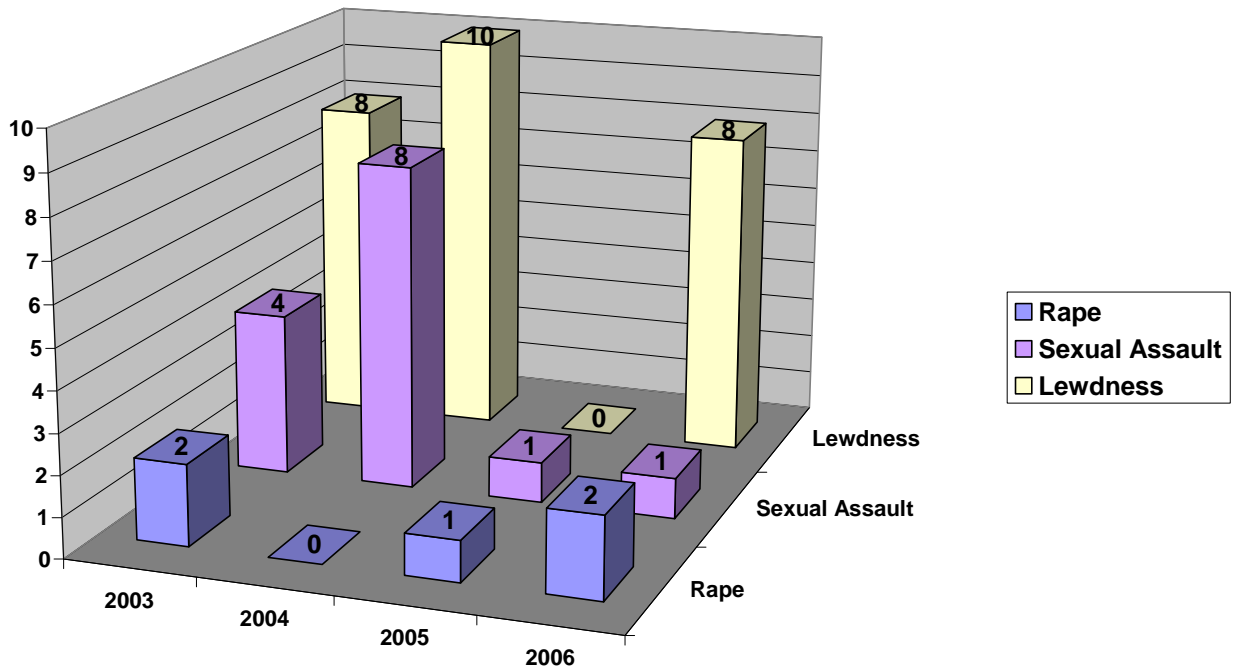

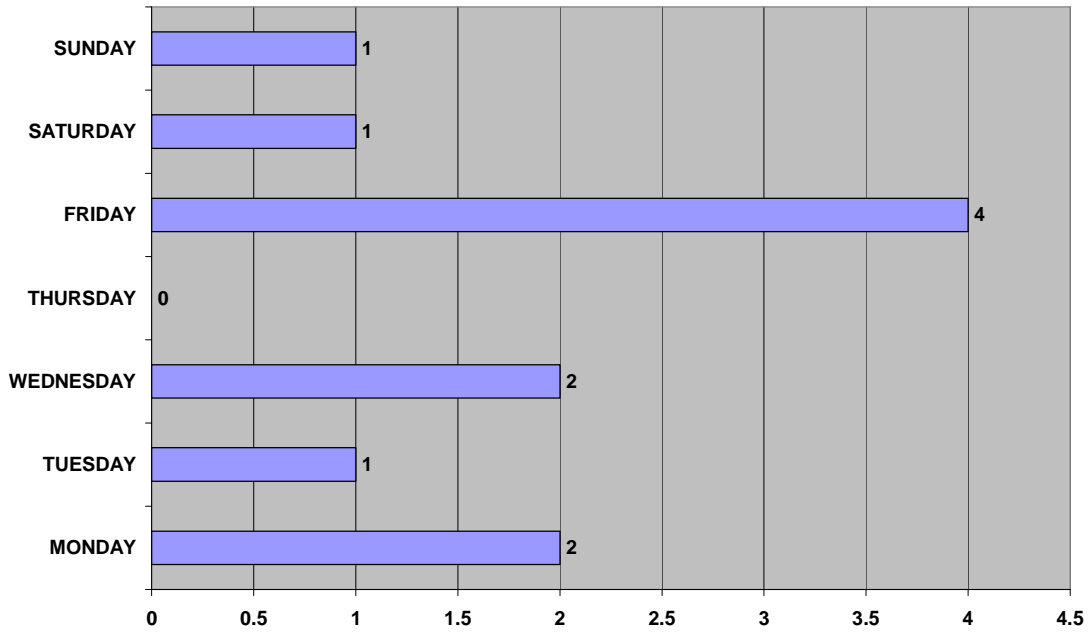

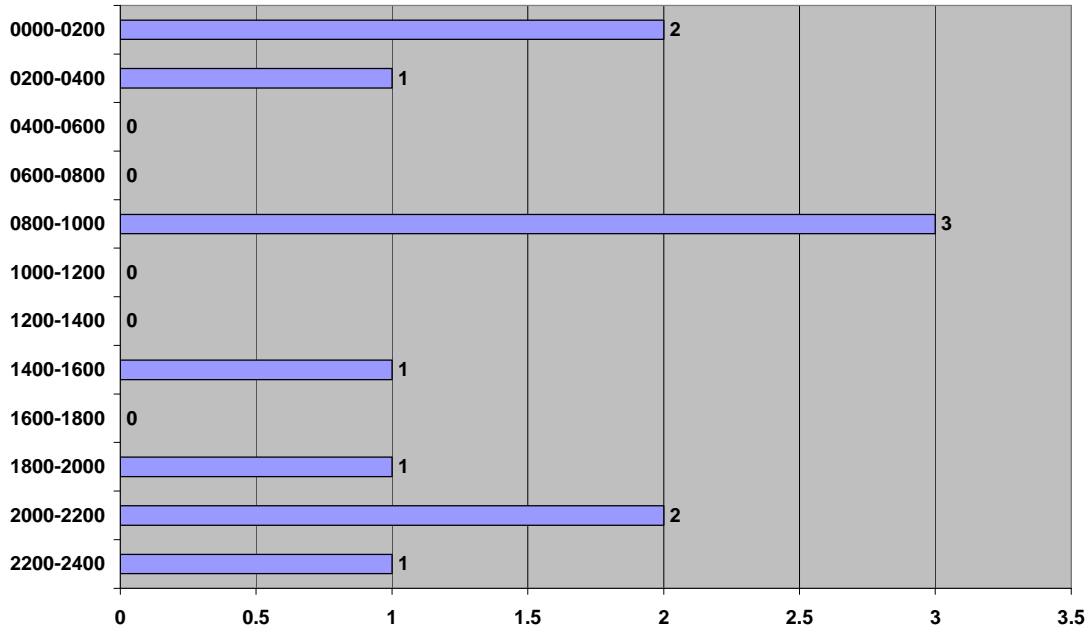

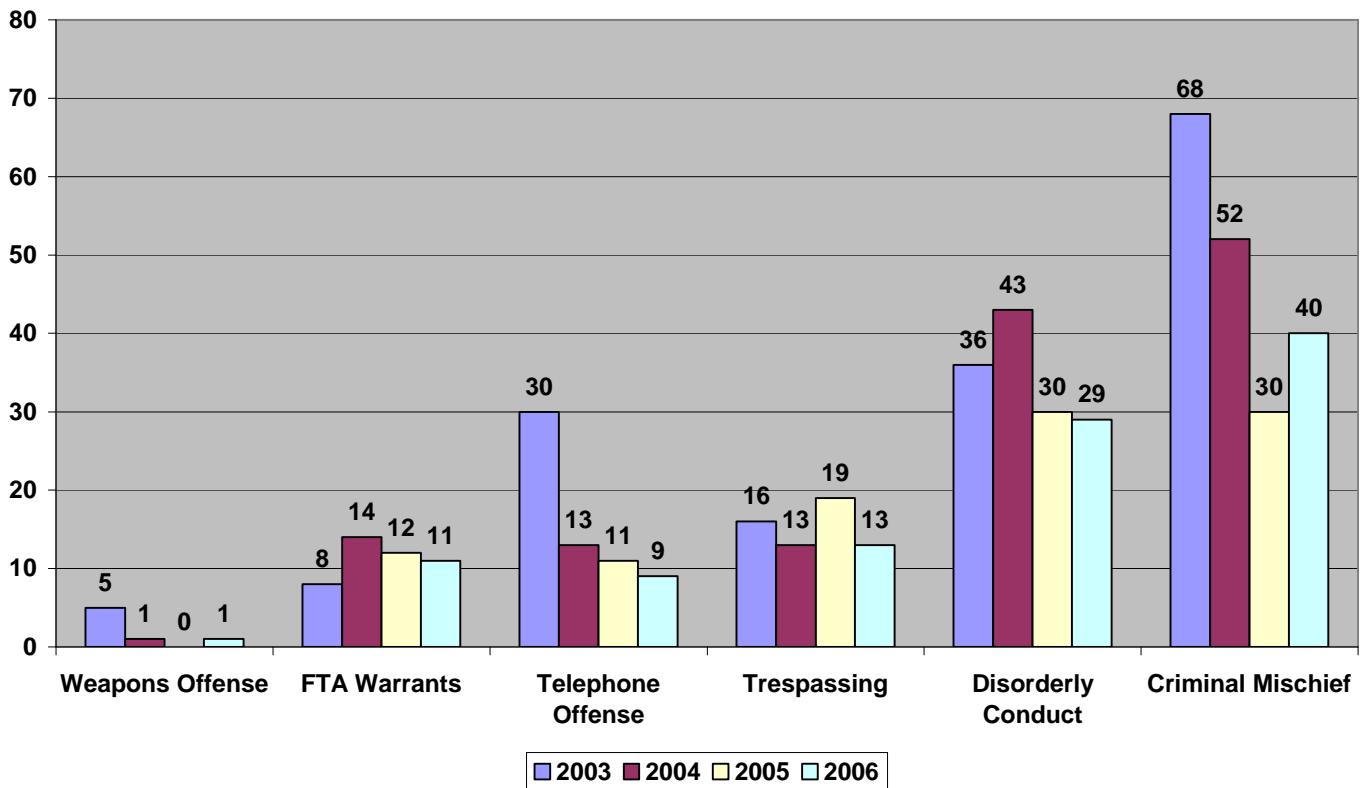
SEX OFFENSES PER DAY OF THE WEEK



SEX OFFENSES PER HOUR OF THE DAY

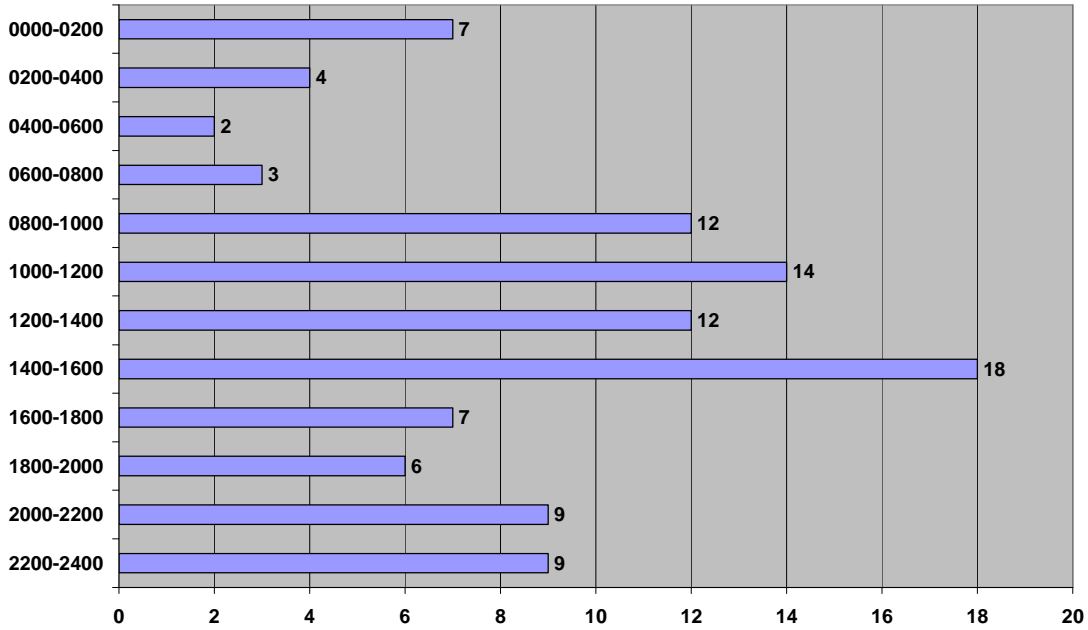

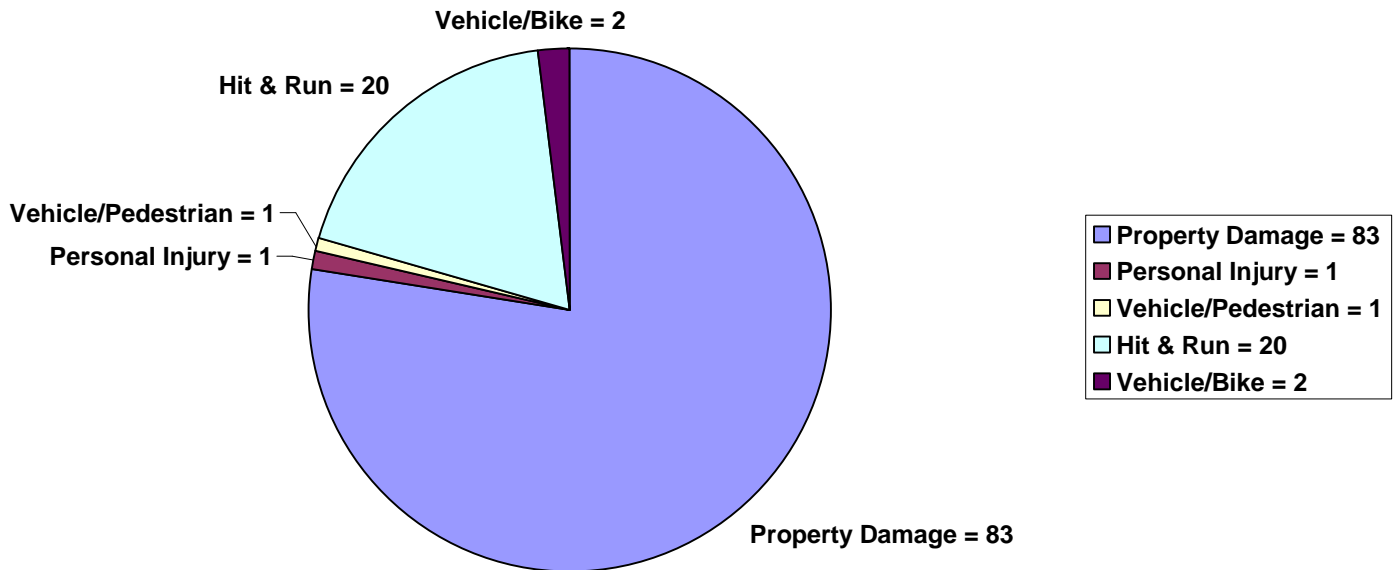

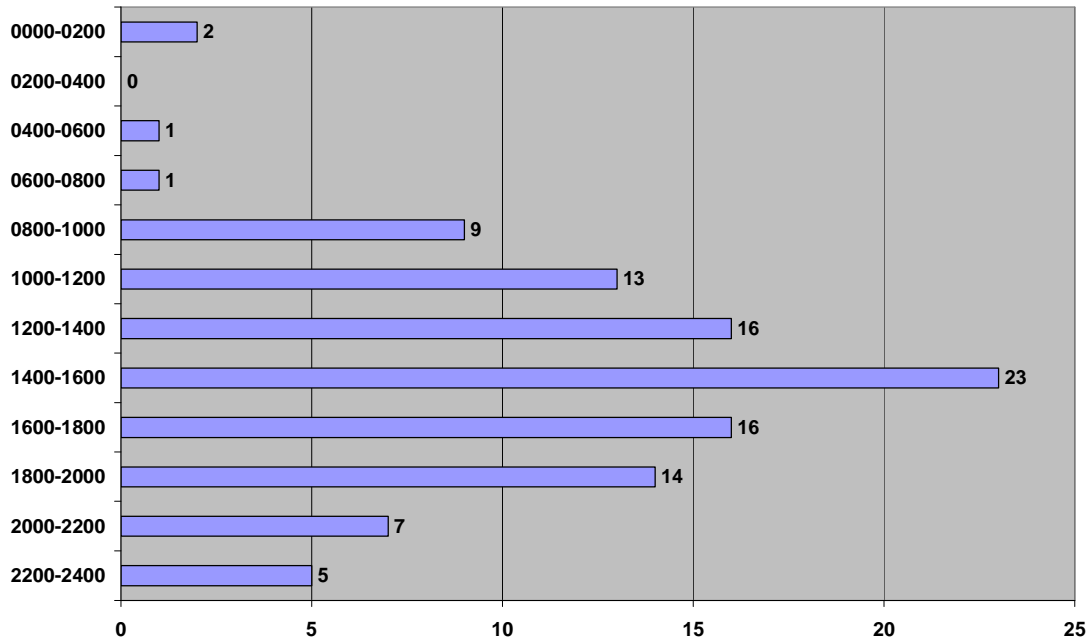

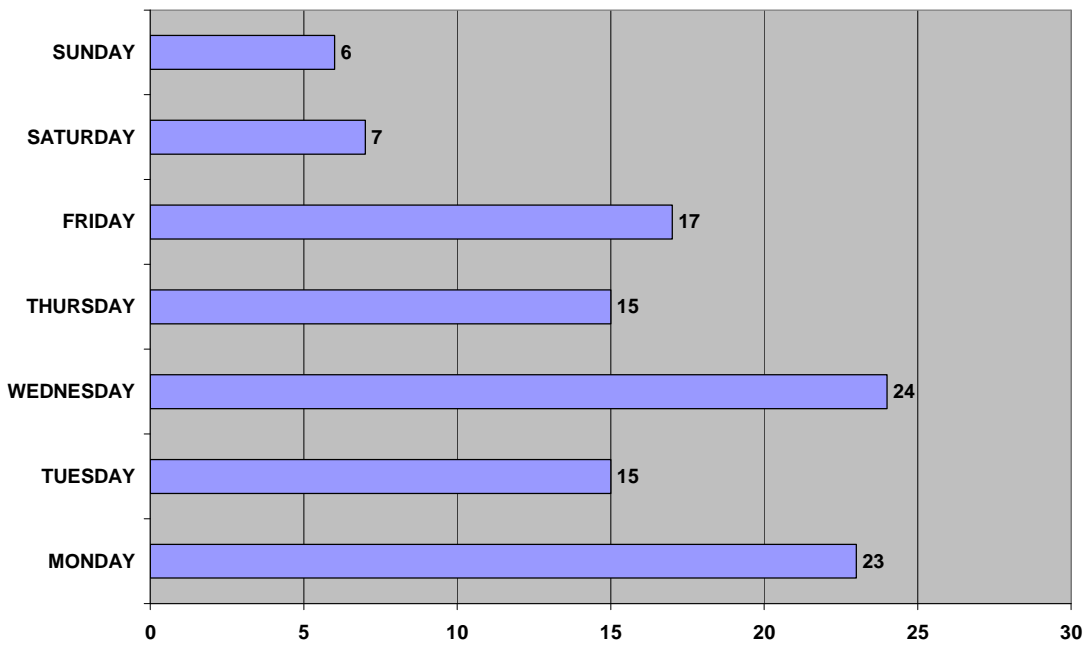

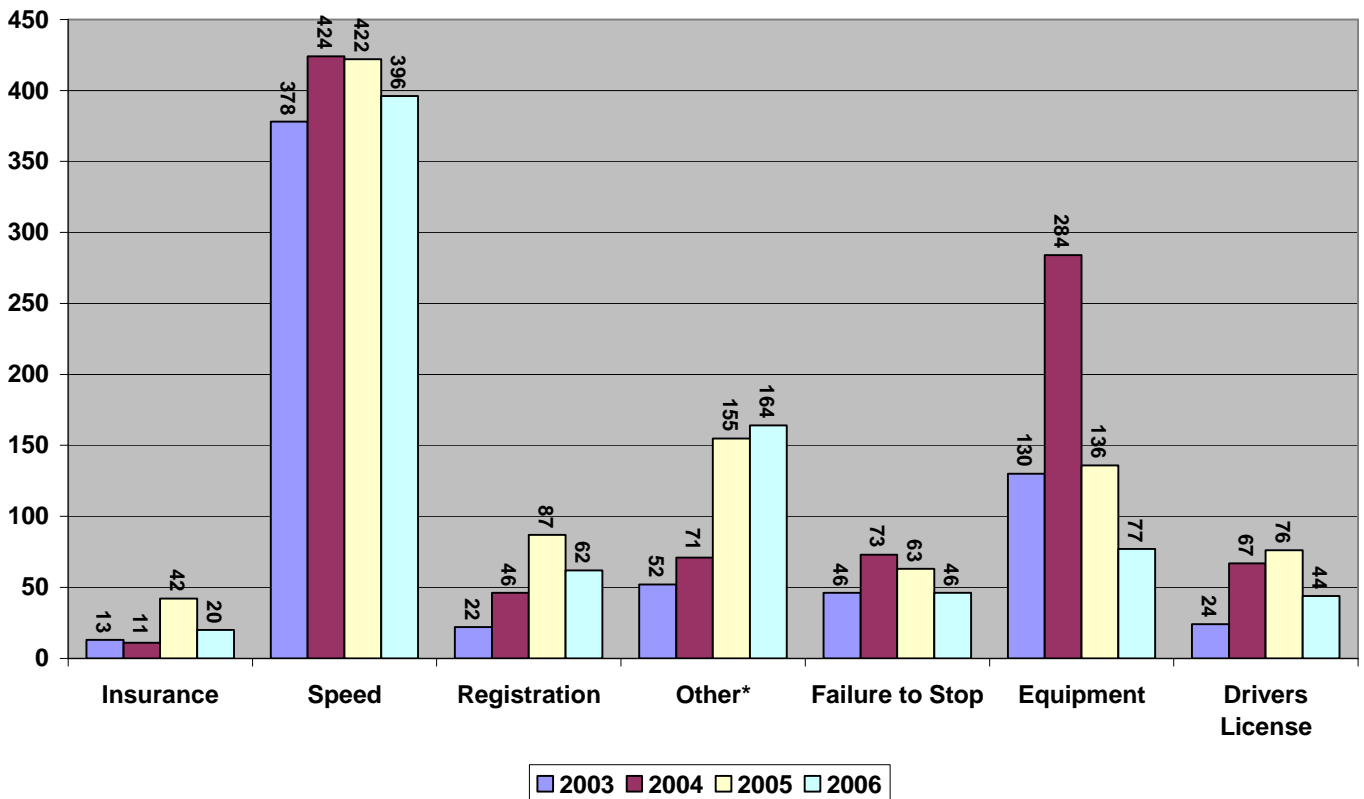
TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS BY HOUR OF THE DAY

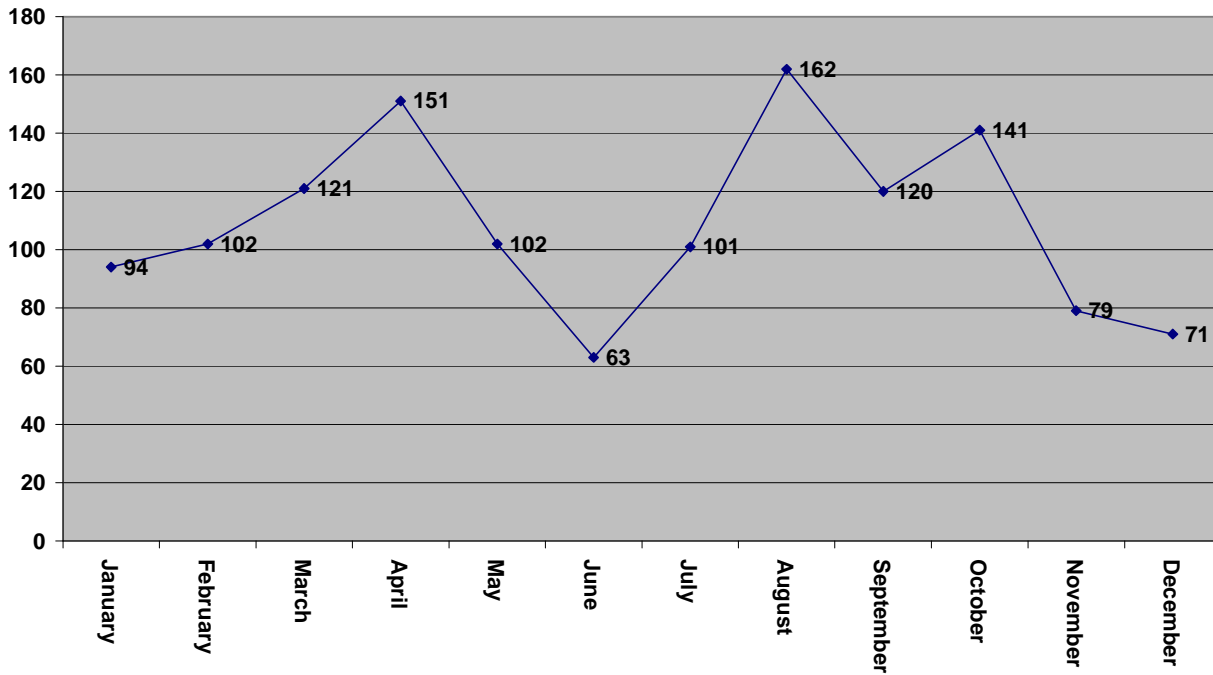

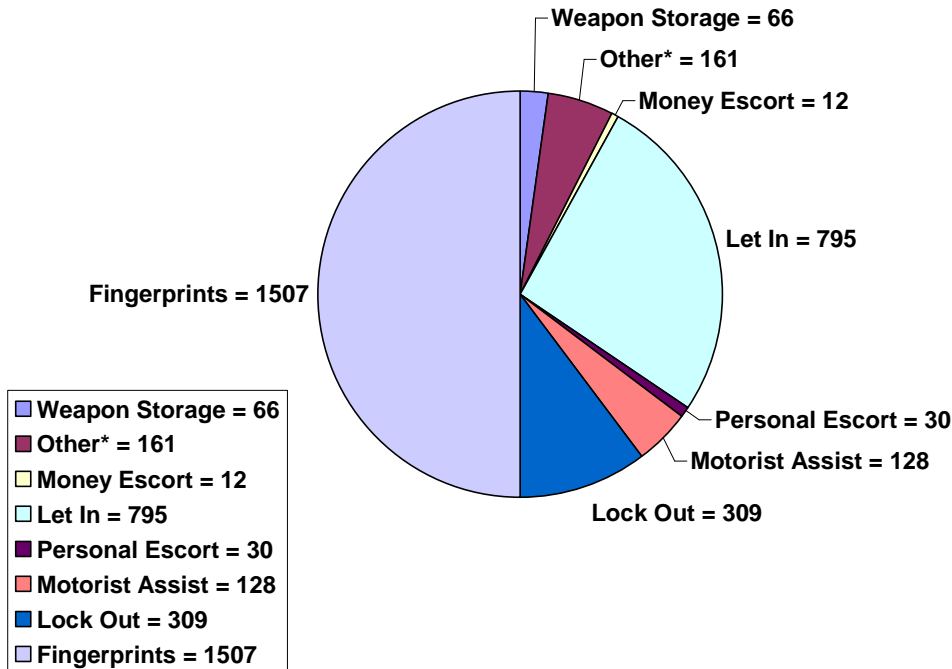

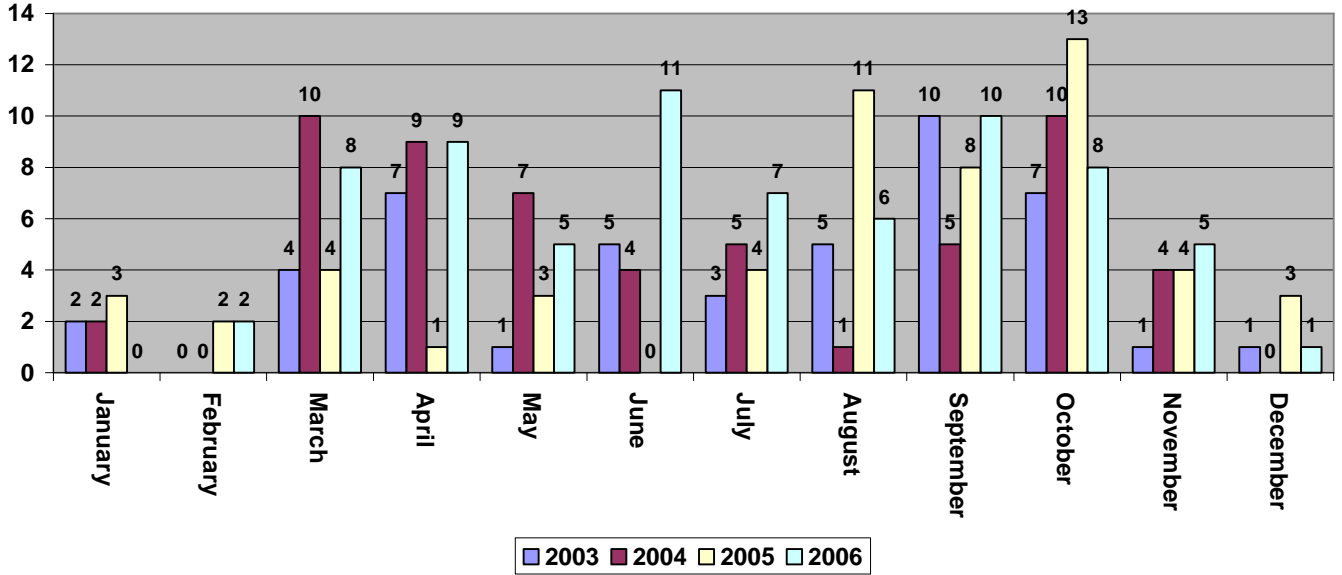
