Parking Permit Rates**

The Parking and Transportation Department is a self supportive enterprise: Meaning, cost recovery must be adequate to pay for all related operational expenses. The needed revenue is generated from a variety of parking fees. The new west campus parking terrace will require additional parking revenue of \$380,000/year beginning in FY 2007 to cover the annual bond payment.

Because the new parking terrace does not generate adequate revenues for the bond payments on its own, an increase in permit rates for everyone who parks a vehicle on campus is needed. The parking rate increases do not result in the accumulation of large fund balances. The plan is merely to cover costs including the parking portion of the bond payment for the new project.

The following parking permit rates have been calculated to cover the aforementioned cost. The parking fee increases result from an analysis of the operational costs of the new terrace, ongoing operational costs of all other parking facilities including consideration for inflation, and code compliance changes needing to occur in the existing parking terrace. The Parking Advisory Committee studied the analysis and recommendations prepared by Parking and Transportation Services. After careful consideration, including a number of changes suggested by the Parking Advisory Committee, the following rate schedule was unanimously approved.
