Undergraduate Scholarships

At least 260 scholarships are awarded annually in the Huntsman School of Business. Undergraduate Huntsman School of Business students need to fill out only **one** application form to be considered for **all** scholarships. Applications are available in the Huntsman School of Business Career and Education Opportunities Center (Business 309).

Jon M. Huntsman School of Business scholarships include the following:

Delonne and Margaret Anderson Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving student with average academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Bank of Utah Scholarship. Recipient must be a junior or senior full-time business student having a 3.5 or higher GPA and demonstrating financial need.

Seth Langton and Orita Smith Barber Scholarship. Recipient must have a major within the Huntsman School of Business, have a GPA of 3.5 or better, and be able to demonstrate financial need.

Haven J. and Bonnie E. Barlow Scholarship. Awarded to a dedicated student having financial need and making progress toward a degree in the Huntsman School of Business.

Beta Alpha Psi Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving student with an accounting major.

Gary Black and Karen Walton Black Scholarship. Recipient should be a business major interested in entrepreneurship. Preference given to students from Davis County, Utah.

Karen Dunn Black Scholarship. Presented to junior or senior student who has financial need and a minimum GPA of at least 3.0.

Mary McAllister and Mark Bold Scholarship. Given to an outstanding out-of-state business student.

Lorenzo J. Bott Scholarship. Recipient should be an outstanding accounting student who will be pursuing a career as a CPA.

Dale S. and Ruth O. Bowen Scholarship. Recipient must be a junior or senior who has achieved advanced standing and has a minimum GPA of 3.5.

George B. and Edna S. Bowen Scholarship. Recipients should be juniors or seniors with advanced standing and a minimum GPA of 3.5.

James W. and Gayle L. Brackner Scholarship in the School of Accountancy. Recipient should be a USU student majoring in accounting.

Brian R. and Natalie Israelsen Broadbent Scholarship. Recipient should be a junior or senior majoring in finance, having financial need, and having a minimum 3.5 GPA.

James E. Brown Scholarship. Awarded to a student with high academic record and financial need.

Vernon M. and Maree C. Buehler Endowed Scholarship. Awarded to an accounting major with demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Vernon M. Buehler Scholarship Honoring Dr. Larzette G. Hale. Awarded to an accounting major who has demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Vernon M. Buehler Scholarship Honoring Glenn D. Morris. Provided to a deserving management or human resource management major showing academic achievement, financial need, and personal integrity.

Vernon M. Buehler Scholarship Honoring Dr. Jean Pratt in the Management Information Systems Department. Recipient must be admitted to the Huntsman School of Business and demonstrate financial need and personal integrity.

Vernon M. Buehler Scholarship Honoring Brent Sandberg '85. Awarded to an accounting major with promising leadership potential, financial need, and above-average scholastic record.

Richard and Laura Buist Endowed Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving senior or graduate accounting student having an interest in information systems.

Herschell K. Bullen Scholarship. Awarded to a junior or senior having a major within the Huntsman School of Business and a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Reed Bullen Scholarship. A four-year scholarship given to a bilingual business major, with preference to Spanish, who has a 3.5 or higher GPA from a Utah high school, preferably one located within the Wasatch Front area.

Norman S. and Virginia Cannon Scholarship. Awarded to a business major.

Frederick Winton Champ Scholarship. Awarded to a sophomore, junior, or senior enrolled in the Huntsman School of Business. Recipient must demonstrate a strong desire to obtain a bachelor's degree.

George H. "Herb" and Helen Champ Scholarship. Recipient must be a junior or senior business major having a minimum 3.5 GPA. Preference given to students majoring in accounting, finance, or business administration.

Daryl and Alice Chase Scholarship. Candidates must demonstrate financial need.

William H. "Bill" and Patricia Child Scholarship. Awarded to an upper-division student majoring in marketing.

Dr. Barbara G. Christensen Scholarship. Awarded to a student with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who demonstrates financial need and personal integrity.

W. Boyd and Jean C. Christensen Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving student with a major in the Huntsman School of Business and a GPA of 3.3 or higher.

Garold (Chris) and Leah Dunford Christensen Scholarship. Awarded to a student with academic achievement and financial need.

Orson A. and Rae N. Christensen Scholarship. Awarded to a Huntsman School of Business student who shows scholarship, integrity, and leadership.

W. Boyd and Jean C. Christensen Scholarship. Student must demonstrate financial need, personal integrity, and average academic achievement.

Newel Comish Scholarship. Awarded to an honest graduating senior with a top GPA who is majoring in marketing.

Frank A. Condie Scholarship. Given to an outstanding accounting major.

Brad H. Dance Memorial Scholarship. Awarded to two students, one male and one female, with academic achievement and financial need.

D. A. Davidson Scholarship. Given to a finance student based on performance working with the D. A. Davidson portfolio.

Darrell and Jean Deem Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving student having financial need and a 2.75 to 3.25 GPA.

Electrical Wholesale Scholarship. Awarded to junior or senior students having a major within the Huntsman School of Business, a GPA of at least 3.0, and financial need.

J. A. Faylor Scholarship. Awarded to an outstanding junior or senior enrolled in the Huntsman School of Business

First Security Foundation Scholarship. Awarded to a sophomore or junior who is studying banking and finance.

V. D. Gardner Scholarship. Given to an outstanding accounting major.

Larzette G. Hale Accounting Student Scholarship. Awarded to assist student groups and circumstances from which the School of Accountancy has had difficulty attracting qualified students.

Hansen Scholarship. Each semester 100 scholarships are awarded to students who are not already covered by full-tuition scholarships. To qualify for this scholarship assistance, students must be enrolled for at least 6 credits in 3000-, 4000-, or 5000-level Huntsman School of Business courses.

Ronald S. Hanson Scholarship. Awarded to a student with high academic achievement who has a major within the Huntsman School of Business.

Russell Hanson Scholarship. Awarded to a business major with academic achievement.

William Clark Headlee Family Scholarship. Awarded to a student from Sevier County, Utah. Awarded by the Richfield Rotary.

Floris S. Henderson Scholarship. Awarded to a student majoring in management information systems.

Hendricks Family Scholarship. Recipients must be in good academic standing and have financial need. Preference given to students living in Lewiston, Richmond, or Cove, Utah.

Mark K. Holland and Wendi Paskins Holland Scholarship. Recipients must have a major within the Huntsman School of Business. Preference given to children of single mothers.

Barbara Fitzgerald Hulme and David K. Hulme Scholarship. Presented to students having a major within the Huntsman School of Business and demonstrating achievement and financial need.

David and Barbara Hulme Accounting Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving accounting major with financial need.

IMA Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving student with a major in accounting.

Gregory Hyrum Ipson Memorial Scholarship. Recipients must be business majors having a minimum 3.0 GPA. Students must be involved in a service-oriented program and/or organization at USU, and must also demonstrate financial need.

Vernon L. Israelsen Scholarship. Awarded to a junior or senior student majoring in economics, based on academic promise, character, and citizenship. Student must be an American citizen with financial need.

Bruce H. Jensen Scholarship. Student must be a well-rounded business major, a Utah resident, and have financial need.

David L. and Lynda F. Jeppesen Scholarship. Awarded to an Aggie football player who is a junior or senior, has a major within the Huntsman School of Business, and has a GPA of at least 2.5.

MK and Ellen Rae Jeppesen Scholarship. Awarded to a student interested in pursuing a career in information technology or contract management with an emphasis in accounting, or to a student having an interest in retailing and marketing, sewing, clothing construction and design, and/or Family and Consumer Sciences Education/Extension.

Joseph and Tamara Keller Endowed Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving accounting student.

KeyBank Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving junior or senior with demonstrated financial need and having a major within the Huntsman School of Business.

M & M Scholarship. Student must be pursuing a degree in business or engineering. Scholarship will rotate between colleges. Awarded according to the following order of preference: residents of California, residents of Utah, and lastly all other persons who satisfy the criteria. Given based on academic merit and demonstrated financial need.

Helen Pise Malko Scholarship. Awarded to a female business administration student with a GPA of at least 3.0 and advanced standing.

Maxcomm Scholarship. Given to an outstanding business major.

Leonard W. McDonald Scholarship. Recipients should be juniors or seniors majoring in economics. Must demonstrate financial need and have a GPA of at least 3.0.

Gene W. and Ruth Miller Family Scholarship. Given to a student majoring in business administration.

Steve Milovich, Sr. Scholarship. Provided to a junior or senior student with a declared major in human resource management, a GPA of 3.0 or higher, and demonstrated financial need.

James R. Minkler Scholarship. Recipient should be an upper-division student majoring in finance, having a desire to obtain a degree, and having demonstrated financial need.

Robert B. and Beverlee Zollinger Murray Scholarship. Awarded to an exceptional student having a major within the Huntsman School of Business.

Murray Scholar Scholarship. Given to an outstanding business major.

National Advisory Board Scholarship. Recipients must be outstanding students with a major in the Huntsman School of Business.

Richard L. and Alaine Nelson Scholarship. Awarded to a deserving student with a major in the Huntsman School of Business.

David B. and Susan W. Stephens Scholarship. Awarded to a junior or senior having a major within the Huntsman School of Business. Must have advanced standing, a 3.0 or higher GPA, and financial need.

Steven and Betty Stokes Scholarship. Awarded to a female student with a major in the Huntsman School of Business who has an interest in entrepreneurship and has financial need.

Bert L. and Barbara Palmer Thomas Scholarship. Given to a junior or senior business student. No recipient shall be given this scholarship for more than one year.

H. Ward and Helen Roghaar Thomas Scholarship. Awarded to a business student of junior or senior standing who has a GPA of 3.0 or higher and shows promise for success.

Tim Roghaar Thomas Scholarship. Awarded to a student of junior or senior standing who is majoring in accounting.

Utah Business Week Scholarship. Recipients must be graduates of Utah Business Week. Proof of acceptance to and enrollment at USU is required. Preference given to students who have outstanding participation during Utah Business Week and who in-

tend to apply to the Huntsman School of Business and complete a business degree.

Robert L. and Patricia W. Wangsgard Scholarship. Awarded to a senior student desiring to own his or her own business.

Dean William L. Wanlass Scholarship. Available to students majoring in economics who demonstrate financial need, have personal integrity, and have academic achievement of at least a 3.75 GPA.

Wells Fargo Bank Scholarship. Two scholarships awarded annually to sophomore or junior students studying banking and/or finance.
