

GRK 3300/4300
Plato's *Apology* and Euripides' *Alcestis/Hippolytus*

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Office Hours: MWF 1:30-2:30 (Damen); TR 12:00-1:30 (Hall)

Textbooks: *Plato: Apology*, ed. James J. Helm (text and commentary)
Euripides: Alcestis, ed C.A.E. Luschnig (text and commentary)
Euripides: Hippolytus (selections to be handed out in class)

Purpose of the Class: The purpose of this class is to read selections from Plato and Euripides for pleasure and profit and to improve students' understanding of these ancient texts, both grammatically and historically.

Grades: Final grades will be determined by students' performance on two tests (each 25% of the final grade), daily vocabulary quizzes (25%), and out-of-class assignments (25%). Make-ups and incompletes will be given only in strict accordance with university policy. Students must abide by the standards of Academic Honesty as stipulated in the Schedule of Courses (p.103). The final will be administered only at the appointed time (Wednesday, December 12, 11:30 -1:20 p.m.; Main 323L). The grading scale will be: A (100-92), A- (92-90), B+ (90-88), B (88-82), and so on. F represents a grade below 60 and is Unsatisfactory.

Greek 3300: GRK 3300 students will have translation homework assignments roughly half as long as those in GRK 4300. In addition to translating the assigned text, GRK 3300 students will be expected to take daily vocabulary quizzes. They will also complete weekly grammar worksheets to be turned in by the beginning of the next class period. Finally, there will be two equally weighted tests composed of translation exercises and grammar questions, along with an optional bonus essay.

Greek 4300: GRK 4300 students will be held to a high standard of translation both in daily assignments and on tests. They will also be assigned longer passages than those students in GRK 3300. Advanced students will complete daily vocabulary quizzes (but not weekly grammar worksheets); instead, they will write a final research paper on one of the themes discussed in class (to be outlined later). Test given to GRK 4300 students will include both seen and unseen translation, a short out-of-class essay, and optional bonus grammar questions.

During the course of the term I reserve the right to make changes in this syllabus as necessary. All changes will be announced in class. Students are responsible for keeping abreast of changes.
