**Class Goals:** The goal of this class is to read, begin to understand, and enjoy Vergil's masterpiece, *The Aeneid*. Classwork will consist largely of translation and discussion of Book 4, the love affair of Dido and Aeneas.

**Required Text:** Clyde Pharr, *Vergil's Aeneid: Books I-VI*

**Tests and Grades:**

Attendance and preparation	25%

The three equally-weighted tests (including the final) will consist of prepared and sight translation, grammar questions, and commentary on passages from Vergil's *Aeneid*. The remaining quarter of your grade will be based on attendance, preparation, and accuracy of translation. Each student will be allowed three absences without question; after that, I will subtract one point per absence from your final grade.
