Course Goal

Expected Learner Outcomes

Students demonstrate listening comprehension, reading, spoken English, and writing skills* by . . .

- a) summarizing main points
- b) identifying details and main ideas
- c) answering questions related to the content
- d) completing oral and written tasks using correct grammar and vocabulary

Typical Classroom Topics/Activities

- pre-listening activities
- group and partner work including presentations
- class and group discussions
- listening-based tests with multiple choice, short answer, true-false, etc.
- journal writing
- vocabulary building activities such as listening for specific words
- discussion of issues and experiences in course content that is related to the students' lives
- roleplays
