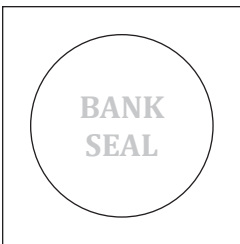

- Official Academic Transcripts:** Please submit official, certified transcripts of all of your academic coursework beyond the ninth year of formal schooling. Specifically, you must submit official school records that:
 - Represent the equivalent of the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth American secondary school grades and any post-secondary, college, or university courses you have taken.
 - Provide a complete list of all subjects studied, marks received, examinations passed, and diplomas, certificates, and degrees awarded.
 - Are accompanied by an official English translation, if original transcripts are not printed in English.
 - In certain countries, official school transcripts may not be available. In these cases, Utah State University may accept “Certified True” copies of student transcripts. Certified True copies must carry the original signature of the school principal and original school certification or seal.
