

Dual Listing of Courses

No courses should be dual listed within the 1000-5000 range. No courses numbered below 4000 should be dual listed with graduate courses. The Educational Policies Committee (EPC) should coordinate with the Graduate Council on dual-listed courses, and a mechanism should be established to verify that additional requirements for graduate students are significant and clearly specified. As published in the *General Catalog*, the course description for the graduate-level course should clearly explain the extra work (e.g., additional readings and papers) which will be required for a student to receive credit toward a graduate degree. The Course Approval Form should also include the justification for offering the undergraduate-level course and the graduate-level course as a dual listing, rather than as two separate courses.
