

The Society for Range Management – Utah Section L. A. Stoddart Scholarship

The Utah section of SRM will be awarding two **\$1,500** scholarships for the **2011-2012** academic years. **The scholarship competition is open to students who currently are sophomore or juniors in a range or range-related program at a Utah university.** Applicants must also be members of the Society for Range Management. Past recipients of the scholarship may also apply, however preference will be given to those who have not received the scholarship in the past.

Applications must be received on or before **March 1, 2011**. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of GPA, activity level with the Society for Range Management which includes involvement with a university range club, demonstrated leadership, letters of recommendations, essay and potential to contribute to the range management profession.

Required application materials

- Cover letter that introduces the student and describes career goals and activities in SRM and/or other range-related organizations. Include the following information: Name, birth date, address, e-mail, university, major, and expected semester of graduation.
- Transcripts for all undergraduate institutions attended which include both courses taken and GPA on a 4-point scale (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).
- Two letters of recommendation.
- An essay (2-page maximum) on "Identify and discuss resource management strategies and techniques that can reduce the frequency of large scale wild fires."
