The poster session is a chance for SAF's student members to present their ideas and projects on some of the restoration challenges they see for forest management. Keeping with the *Restoration Forestry* theme of the meeting, posters should present ideas, projects, or research needs that address restoring forest ecosystems. Posters can explore topics as diverse as forest roads, harvest systems, silviculture, wildlife habitat structure, stream riparian areas, invasive species, or other forest management topics that relate to restoration. Posters will be judged by the meeting attendees based on content, organization and appearance.

“Restoration Forestry Challenges – What Needs to be Restored and Why?”

Restoration is defined in The Dictionary of Forestry as “the process of returning ecosystems or habitats to their original structure and species composition.” Restoration Forestry is beginning to emerge as a focus and goal for many foresters, landowners and agencies. NorCal SAF is joining with the Intermountain SAF to explore the need for and goals and practices of Restoration Forestry. The meeting will bring together some of the leading experts on the need for Restoration Forestry. Speakers will also look at some of the ongoing projects that are continuing to shape our perspective on why restoration may be a more important part of forest management in the future. The program will provide a forum for debate on whether Restoration Forestry is a shift in policy or just the continued growth of the science and practice of forest management.
