



Night patrol on the Warm Fire

Fire on the North Rim September 12 and 13, 2008

Friday, September 12

- 10:30 am Meet at the Kaibab Visitor Center, Jacob Lake, Arizona
- 10:30 – 11:30am Orientation and Overview of the Warm Fire
- 11:30am – 1:00pm Lunch at the Jacob Lake Inn, order off the menu
- 1:00pm Visit various sites within the 2006 Warm Fire to observe recovery and see the varying impacts of the fire
- 6:00pm Meal at Kaibab Lodge, order off of the menu

Saturday, September 13

- 8:00 am Depart Kaibab Lodge for tour of various prescribed and wildland fire-use fires in the Grand Canyon National Park
- 12 noon Tours end and the group will be free to spend the rest of the day on their own in the Park

Lodging: Various motel accommodations are available in Kanab and Fredonia. The Jacob Lake Inn may have rooms available. The De Mott Campground (near the Kaibab Lodge) is open. The Jacob Lake Campground is closed for renovation. Dispersed camping is permitted. We have some rooms reserved at the Kaibab Lodge for Friday September 12. The following are the available rooms and rates (pre-tax).

- Six cabins with one double bed \$85
- Two motel style rooms with one double bed and one twin bed \$130
- One motel style room with two double beds \$140
- Note: you can get a roll –away bed for the cabins for an additional \$15.

Transportation: We will be car pooling on the field trips. While roads are either paved or improved gravel, vehicles with clearance are recommended

Meals: You are on your own for breakfast, Saturday lunch, and drinks for the field trips. There is a restaurant at the lodge and a convenience store nearby.
