Dr Bedford, Associate Professor of Geography, at Weber State University has been interested in climate change for over 20 years. His interest in climate change dates back to his undergraduate days at Oxford University in Britain, where he was first exposed to theories about the forces affecting global climate. He pursued this interest with Master's and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Colorado in Boulder, where he was mainly based at the National Snow and Ice Data Center (an institution now frequently cited in news stories about global warming). He continues to be active in teaching and scholarship focusing on climate change and its effects on water resources, with a special interest in the Great Salt Lake.
