

TEST CORRECTIONS
Problems worth 5 points each

10% of your quarter grade comes from test corrections. Corrections on each test are worth 25 pts.. Every student in the class should have 100% of these points

Each problem on the test was worth 5 points. The problems were scored as follows:

Totally correct:	5 pts
Minor error:	4 pts
Conceptual error:	2-3 pts
Small part correct:	1 pt
Totally incorrect:	0 pts

Test corrections are required for any problem where you did not receive 5 points. **Work must be done neatly and completely on separate paper.** Turn your test in along with the corrections.

1. If you received 4 points, rework the problem making sure it is totally correct.
2. If you received 0, 1, 2, or 3 points, you must:
 - a. Rework each problem.
 - b. Give a clear explanation of the concept you didn't understand, computational error you made, equation or formula forgotten, algorithm misused, etc.
 - c. Work **two** additional problems from the textbook. A list will be provided for each test.

Corrections are due 1 week after the original exam is returned to you. You must turn in your exam along with the corrections.
