

## **DECISIONS MADE FROM THE JUNE 2000 - MAY 2001 STATISTICS & EVALUATIONS**

The number of students referred to our office has dropped and the number of students not complying with their judicial mandate increased. The drop in referrals could be due to less students using, but the CORE survey did not indicate this. We decided that we needed to look at the procedures that were developed last year and see if changes need to be made to them. We also met with each key campus department that sends us students, determined ways to improve the procedures and implemented them.

Students completing the course enjoy most aspects of the class. The strong points are the group circles, autobiographies, collages and 12-Step group meetings. We will continue to keep these components. There is no real strong consensus on what needs to be changed. There are as many dislikes as there are students and one person's dislike is another person's favorite aspect. We will continue to watch for any consistent dislikes or areas that need to be changed.
