Sisters near and far can show support

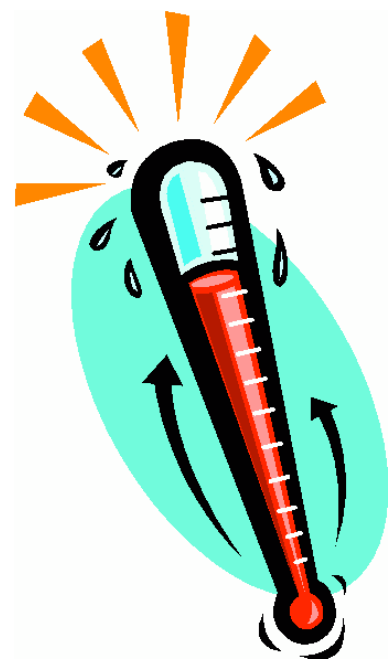
