Remodel Registrars Office	Refurbish	2005	The Cashiers Office was relocated to the Registrars Office which was enlarged to better serve students in a fast and timely manner.
Remodel Advising Office	Refurbish	2005	Provide additional office space to better meet student needs.
Restore/Remodel	Refurbish	2005	Relocate Cashiers Office and restore Juniper Lounge to a lounge that will enhance facilities and provide an appealing atmosphere for students.
Carpet Student Involvement Office	Refurbish	2007	Replace carpet to enhance the office space.
Install Freight Elevator	Refurbish	2007	Replace existing elevator to provide better features and services to departments within the Student Center.
New GLBT Office	Refurbish	2007	Remodel existing office space to provide a new office to meet the needs of GLBT students.
Remodel Retention/First Year Experience Office	Refurbish	2007	The creation of the new office will enhance the experience of students and increase retention.
Remodel Tutor Lab	Refurbish	2007	Provide additional, more functional space for students seeking Math & Statistics Tutoring.
Installation of door in Ballroom	Installation	2007	The installation of a floor to ceiling retractable door to divide the Ballroom to increase the facilities for both campus and off-campus groups.
Remodel of Kitchen and Dinning areas	Refurbish	2007	To provide and offer students, faculty, staff and guests food services with a well-designed and more serviceable space.
Remodel Student Services	Refurbish	2007	Convert an unused coat closet to provide a functional Conference Room for the departments within Student Services.
