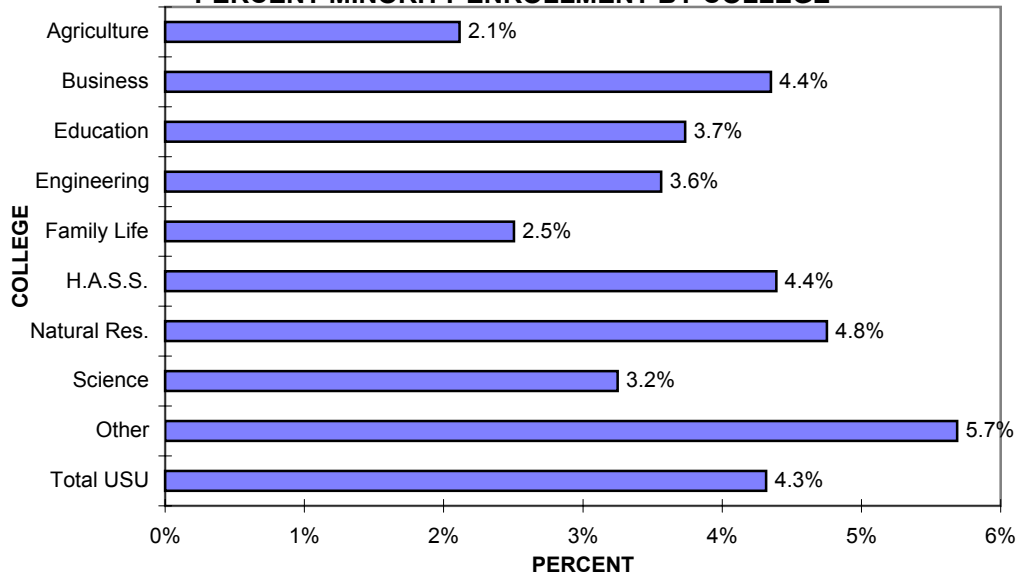

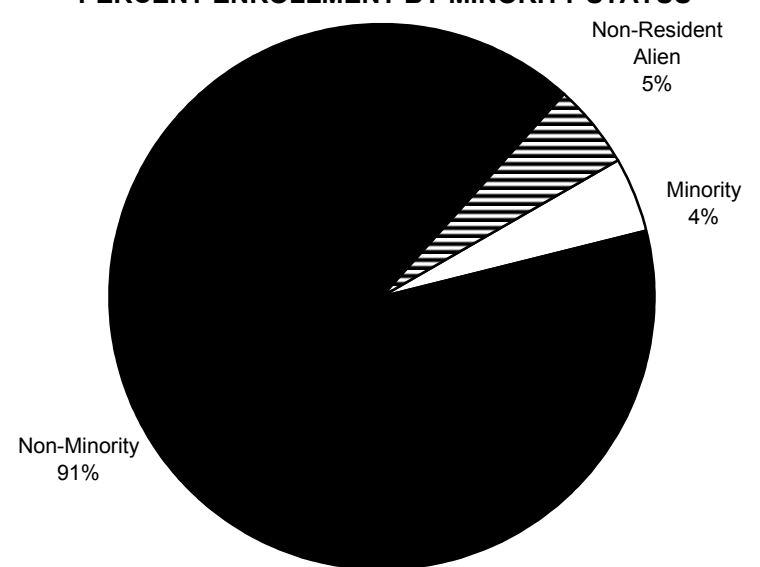

**PERCENT MINORITY ENROLLMENT BY COLLEGE**



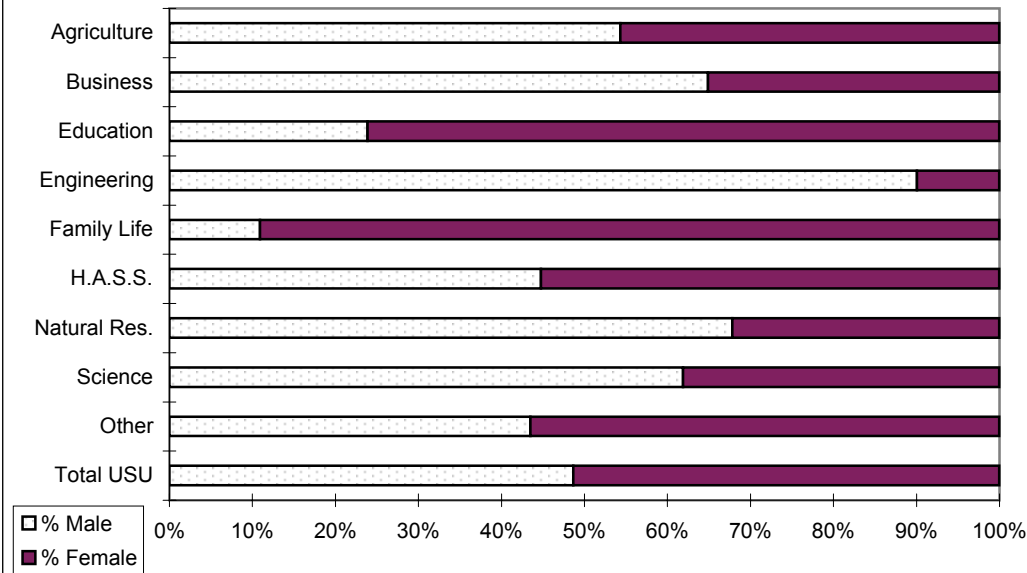
**PERCENT ENROLLMENT BY MINORITY STATUS**



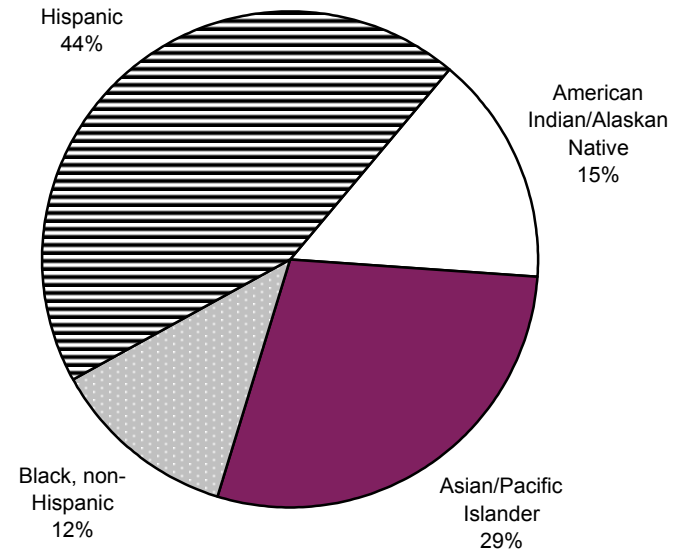

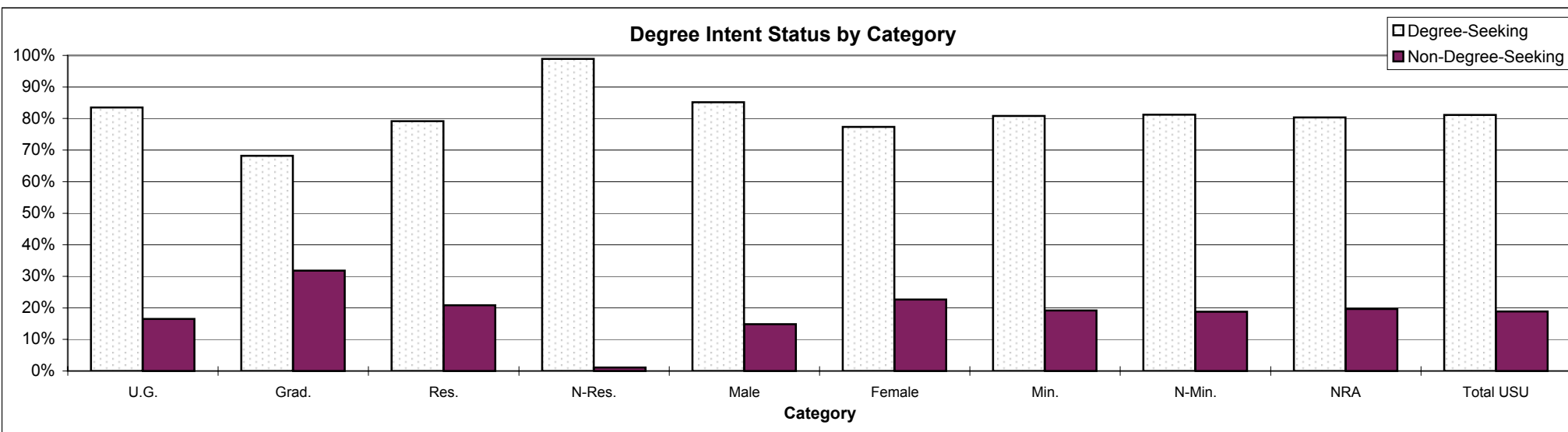

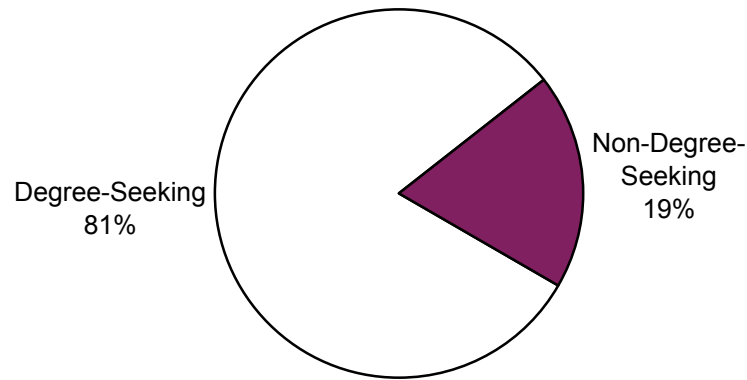

**Degree Intent Status**



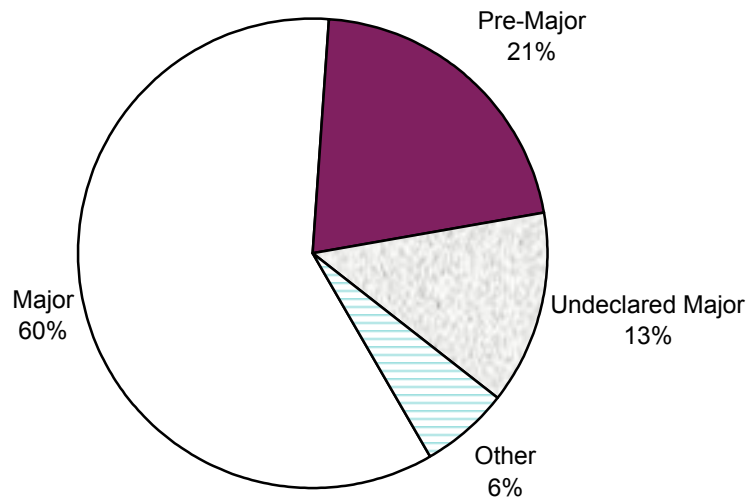
**Change in Reporting**

A new **Graduation Rate Survey** was added to USU's mandated federal Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) reporting in March 1998. Among other things, this survey collects information on the **degree intentions** of students at our institution. Degree-seeking students are defined as *students who are enrolled in courses for credit that are recognized by the institution as seeking a degree or formal award*. (Degree-seeking also includes undergraduates enrolled in vocational or occupational programs.) This new survey has caused a change in some of our reporting, effective Summer 1998. **USU definitions** are as follows:

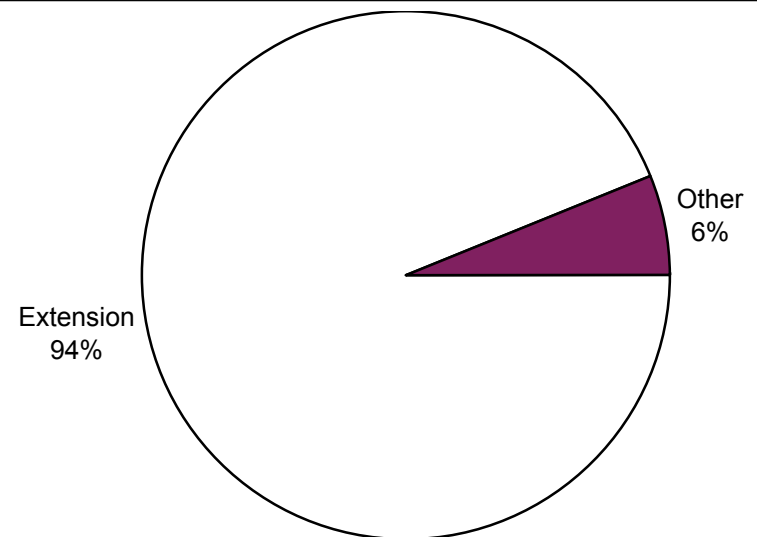
- \* **Degree-seeking** includes individuals who have **formally applied** to USU for admission. This category includes *majors* (previously identified as matriculated), as well as *pre-majors, undeclared (majors)* and students previously included in *miscellaneous* that have formally applied to USU for admission. These latter three categories of students were formerly reported as non-matriculated.
- \* **Non-degree-seeking** includes individuals who have **not formally applied** to USU for admission. This category includes *Extension students* and those students previously included in *miscellaneous* that have not formally applied to USU for admission. These non-degree-seeking students were formerly reported as non-matriculated.

Note: The *Miscellaneous* category has been changed to *Other*.

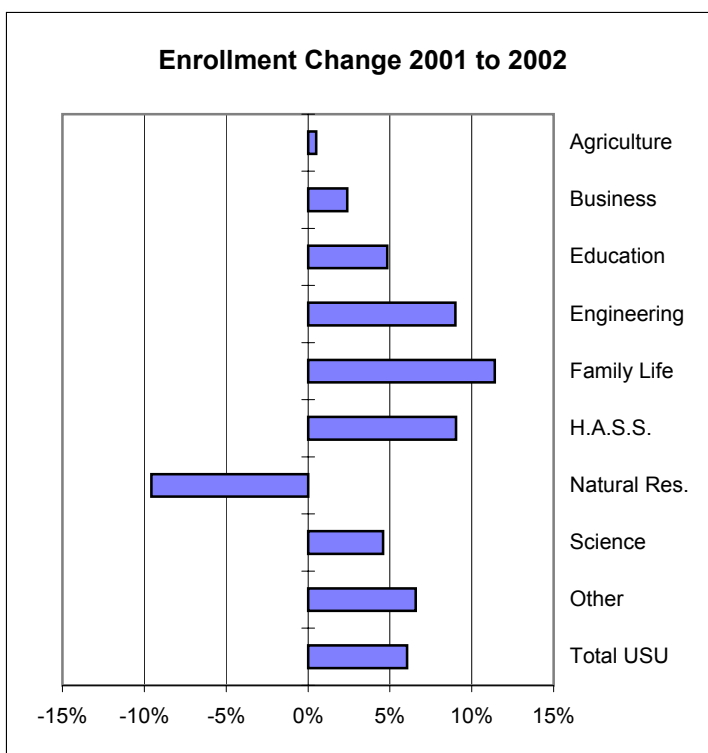
