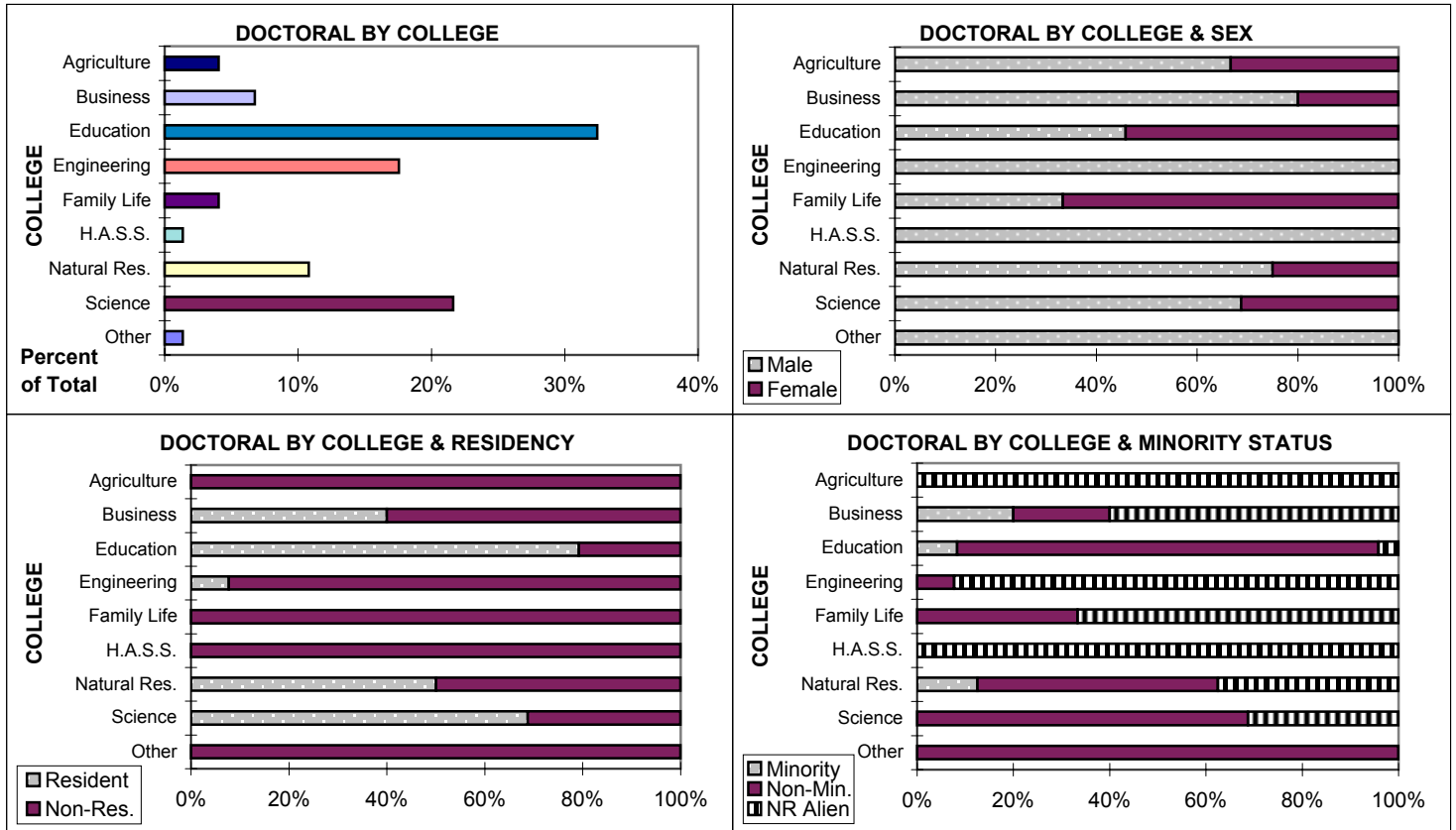
DOCTORAL DEGREES CONFERRED BY SEX, RESIDENCY & MINORITY STATUS

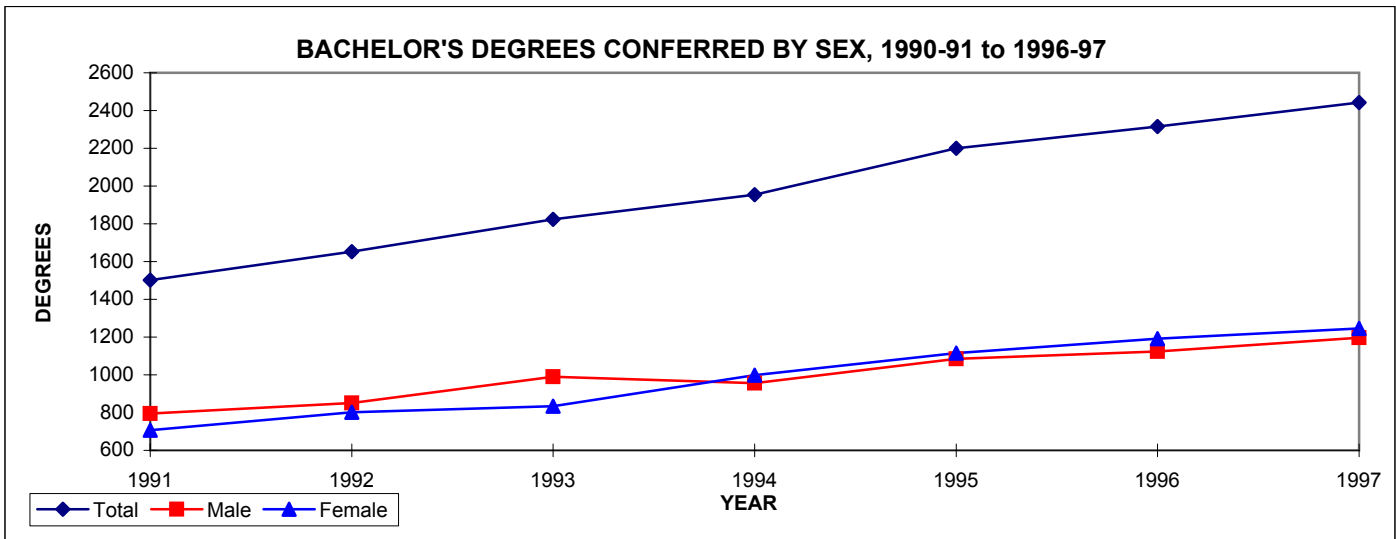

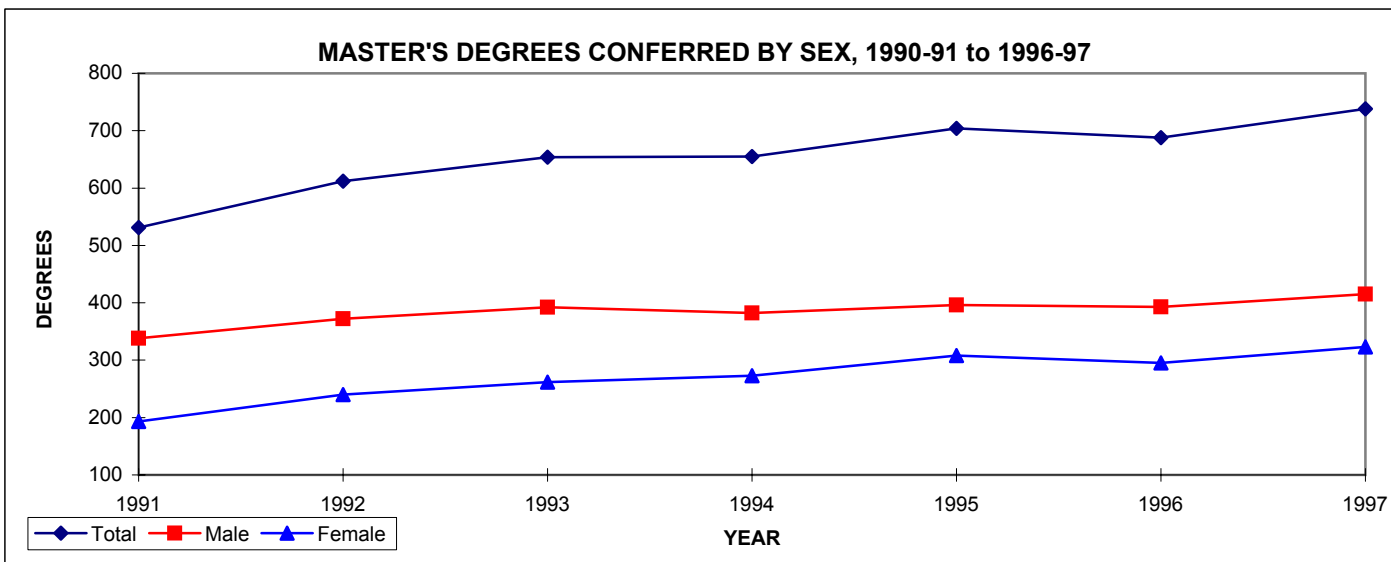

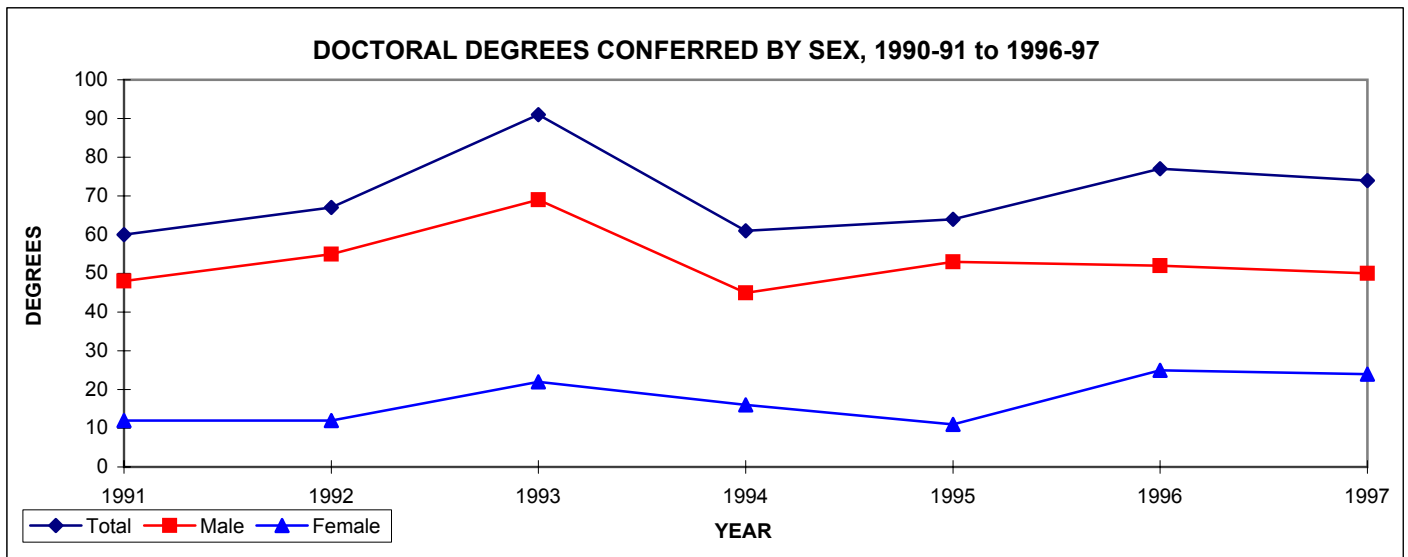
