



Classroom NORMS

Classroom norms create expectations for behavior and set the tone for a positive learning environment. Respecting these norms supports everyone's success.

Formal	Show respect by addressing instructors and classmates appropriately—it reflects your engagement and commitment to learning.
Punctual	Arrive on time and stay engaged until class ends. If late, enter quietly and apologize afterward.
Responsible	Take responsibility for your learning experience. Read the syllabus, take notes, ask questions, and participate in discussions.
Civil	Share opinions thoughtfully and listen openly. Critique ideas, not people.
Available	Expect to study 2-3 hours per class hour. Plan accordingly before taking on jobs or extracurriculars.
Capable	To request accommodations, contact the Counseling Services or the Disability Resource Center.
Humble	Instructors seek to help their students. Ask for help early or meet with an Academic Success Coach.
