

# **USU Club Constitution**

## **Purpose**

The purpose of the USU handball club is to

1. Increase our handball skills and compete in tournaments including the USHA collegiate nationals every February.
2. Create a sense of unity and friendship with the team.

## **Membership**

1. Tryouts will be held at the beginning of every fall semester.
2. Eligibility:
  - a. Membership is open to all full-time undergraduate and graduate students of Utah State University.
  - b. All members must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credit hours per semester.

## **Club Officers**

1. Officer Positions:
  - a. President
  - b. Treasurer
  - c. Secretary
  - d. Travel Safety Officer
2. Officer Duties:
  - a. Officers are responsible for overseeing the daily operations of the Club, including, but not limited to:
    - i. Ordering team gear and merchandise
    - ii. Coordinating travel arrangements for tournaments
    - iii. Organizing fundraising events and handling donations
    - iv. Ensuring compliance with university policies and maintaining the safety of club members during travel
3. Selection of Coaches:
  - a. Coaches are appointed by the officer groups

## **Team Meetings**

1. Meetings may be held throughout the school year to discuss the Club's needs, including upcoming tournaments, travel, fundraising, ect.
2. Officer meetings will be held as needed to discuss administrative matters.

### **Conduct and Discipline**

1. Conduct:
  - a. All members of the USU Handball Club are representatives of Utah State University and are expected to adhere to the university's policies and demonstrate appropriate conduct at all times.
  - b. All members are expected to show respect towards all people including teammates, coaches, officials and opponents.
  - c. Sportsmanship is a high priority and members are expected to exhibit sportsmanship like behavior both on and off the courts.
2. Disciplinary Actions:
  - a. Any disciplinary actions required due to violations of conduct will be handled by the coaching staff and team officers. Consequences may range from warnings to suspension or removal from the Club, depending on the severity of the infraction.

### **Financial Obligations**

1. Club members will be responsible for their club dues (\$25) and some travel costs for tournaments.
