

Utah State University Club Tennis Constitution

I. Club Mission Statement

The goals and objectives of the Utah State University (USU) Club Tennis team include providing a positive and competitive atmosphere for students to engage in the sport of tennis. As an organization, we strive to foster teamwork, sportsmanship, and commitment, while representing Utah State University both on and off the court. Throughout the academic year, members will dedicate themselves to developing their tennis skills, contributing to the club, and supporting the university and local community.

II. Membership Requirements

To become or remain a member of the USU Club Tennis team, individuals must:

- Be a currently enrolled USU student.
- Participate in annual tryouts to determine team placement.
- Pay dues of \$50 per semester.
- Participate in practices, matches, tournaments, and team events.
- Complete all required trainings, sign the necessary waivers, and register through DSE.
- Maintain a positive attitude and sportsmanship both on and off the court.

III. Officers & Officer Duties

Current Presidents: Elle Dunyon & Joseph Murray

The duties of the presidents include:

- Managing communication between the club and the USU Club Sports advisor.
- Overseeing team operations, including practices, events, travel and team management.
- Ensuring that all players meet membership requirements and stay informed of team activities.
- Promoting a positive and inclusive environment for all members.

Other Captains: Lucy Lesueur, Lucas Silva, Isaiah Fawson

The duties of the captains include:

- Assisting the presidents in running practices and coordinating with team members.
- Helping to organize team events, travel arrangements, and tournaments.
- Encouraging teamwork and fostering a supportive team culture.

Officers and captains will be selected based on leadership and dedication to the team. They will only be removed by a unanimous vote from the team or by stepping down.

IV. Club Advisor

The club advisor for USU Club Tennis will be the Coordinator of Club Sports. The advisor's responsibilities include:

- Providing guidance and support to club officers.
- Assisting in communication between the club and university.
- Attending meetings and overseeing compliance with university policies.

V. Team Structure

The USU Club Tennis team will hold tryouts to select members for the A and B teams, each consisting of 4 male and 4 female players. These teams will travel for competitions and represent USU in intercollegiate matches. Players not selected for the A or B teams will still have the opportunity to participate in practices and team activities.

VI. Equal Opportunity Statement

The USU Club Tennis team will provide equal opportunity for membership regardless of gender, race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or disability.

VII. Amendments Procedure

To propose an amendment to this constitution, a club member or officer must present the amendment to the team. If a majority of the team members agree, the amendment will be adopted. Amendments must align with USU Club Sports regulations and will be added to the constitution by the presidents within two weeks of the vote.
