Summertime can present challenges to working families of school age children who must make different arrangements for childcare needs and children's activities. Seventy-six percent of all Utah school age children 5-12 years old have parents in the work force, creating the potential for many children to be left unattended. Many children are not prepared to be left home alone. Children in self-care are more likely to engage in risky behaviors, be truant from school, experience stress, have poor grades and abuse substances. They are susceptible to feelings of loneliness, fear, and boredom. Summer activities are a wonderful way to offer fun, constructive activities to occupy your children's time. Summer activities can give your children learning opportunities that not only help to ease their boredom, but can also help them become well-rounded, socially capable adults.
