

Resource List

Create a local resource list for caregivers and families that is parent friendly and you can easily hand out. The list should have at least eight resources pertaining to special needs. Two of these resources must include places for parents to have their children get assessed/evaluated for a suspected disability. Include contact information for the resource as well as what they offer. If applicable, you can also provide the physical address, website, email address, or any other information you feel may be useful to families.
