

Utah State University Time, Place, and Manner Restrictions for Commencement and Convocations

Purpose: To ensure the safety, accessibility, aesthetics, and orderly conduct of commencement and convocation events on Utah State University's campus, the below articulated time, place, and manner restrictions will be enforced.

Scope: These restrictions apply to all individuals and organizations on USU's campus during commencement and convocation events. The restrictions will apply during all commencement and convocation events. These restrictions do not apply to signs, temporary structures, or temporary outdoor furnishings set up by USU itself.

Restrictions:

- Signs are prohibited inside commencement or convocation venues.
- Signs affixed to USU facilities or property, including to the ground with stakes or other devices outside of commencement or convocation venues or along procession routes are prohibited.
- Temporary structures, including tents, stages, booths, and other such structures are prohibited in all areas of campus during commencement and convocation events.
- Temporary outdoor furnishings, such as tables, chairs, etc. are prohibited outside of commencement or convocation venues or along procession routes.

Permits and Approvals: No permits will be issued for temporary structures during commencement and convocation events.

Enforcement:

- USU will monitor compliance with these restrictions.
- Non-compliant signs, structures, or outdoor furnishings will be subject to immediate removal.
