Utah State University's General Education (GE) program provides the subject-area knowledge and learning skills foundation for its 2 - and 4 -year degrees. Core courses make up the general education foundation. Breadth courses give an opportunity to explore various subjects. General education courses are highly advisable for concurrent enrollment students; they are required for college graduation and transferable from one Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) institution to another. It is possible to complete USU's GE requirements by taking 5 concurrent enrollment classes each junior and senior year, then registering separately for ENGL 2010.
