We are beyond thrilled to announce that after 16 seasons without the use of our fly system in the Caine Lyric Theatre, we anticipate that construction for the renovation of our Stage House and Fly System will begin after the conclusion of the Spring 2025 semester! This is incredible news, and we are so grateful to all those at Utah State University, the Caine College of the Arts, and members of our community and alumni that have worked to make this happen.

As exciting as this is, it does mean that we need to move all our summer programming from the Caine Lyric Theatre to the Morgan Theatre, Black Box Theatre, and Russell/Wanlass Performance Hall on the USU campus. The great news is that we've been using these facilities since 2019 so that our patrons could get to know these spaces in preparation for this exact scenario. In addition, we will be working hard between now and this summer to improve the sound in the Morgan Theatre which will include the ability to offer assisted listening devices for those who have previously found it difficult to hear in this space.
