6. He gave a pat on the back to himself.
7. They gave a pat on the back to themselves.
8. She found the answer in herself.
9. She found the book of Caesar himself.
10. She found the book of Caesar herself (=on her own).
11. She found his book.
12. She found her (own) book.
13. She found her (someone else's) book.
14. His own vices brought him down.
15. We found the truth in that very part of ourselves which few men can face.
