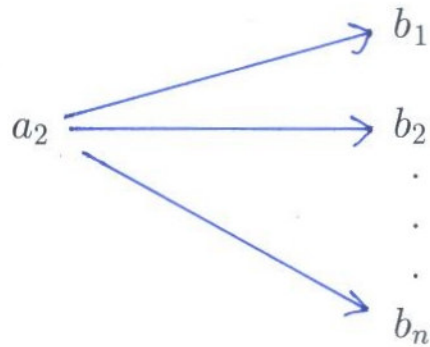
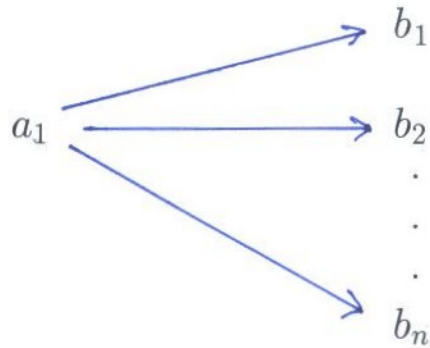


FUNDAMENTAL COUNTING PRINCIPLE:
