Dispersed Camping

Sinks Road

- Numerous locations. For example: [here](#), [here](#) and [here](#)
- Dirt road access, ~50 minutes from the office
- High elevation; snow is likely in early summer and late fall

Temple Fork Road

- Several locations along this road. For example: [here](#) and [here](#)
- Dirt road access, ~30 minutes from the office
- Medium elevation; snow possible on tail ends of season

Turkey Trail

- Handful of dispersed sites. For example: [here](#)
- Dirt road access, ~30 minutes from the office
- Medium elevation; snow possible on tail ends of season

Right Hand Fork

- Several locations along this road. For example: [here](#)
- Paved, ~20 minutes from the office
- Usually clear of snow during summer and fall season

Green Canyon

- Numerous dispersed sites along this road. For example: [here](#), [here](#), [here](#), [here](#) and many others.
- Dirt road access, 15-20 minutes from the office
- Low elevation, usually clear of snow
- Pit toilets available at the parking lot, cell service close to canyon mouth
- Most popular dispersed site for Logan UCC members

- Hours: Open 24 hours
- Fee: \$15 a month membership
- Free Wi-Fi

Logan Rec Center (Showers)

- Hours: 5:30am – 9:30pm M-F, 7am – 7pm Sat., Closed Sun.
- Fee: \$4 per visit (Daily fee includes all amenities)
- Free Wi-Fi

Grocery Shopping

WinCo

- WinCo has a great bulk section and cheapest prices but is cash/debit only. Accepts EBT.

Smith's

- Has decent deals on day-old items but can be more expensive compared to other stores. Accepts EBT.

Big Deal Outlet

- Rescued food, kitchen items, clothing, etc. Extremely low prices. Accepts EBT.

Cache Valley Gardener's Market

- Farmer's market with music, hot food, produce, and more. SNAP benefit value doubled for many purchases. Open every Saturday from May 10th to mid-October 2025, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM, located behind The Historic Courthouse at 199 North Main Street.

SNAC

- Free food (mix of non-perishables, cooked meals, and rescued produce/baked goods), available once per week to USU community members. UCC AmeriCorps members are USU employees.

Cache Community Food Pantry

- Logan's community food pantry

Natural Grocers

- Great for vegan or plant-based options, but it is more expensive than other stores. Accepts EBT.

Local Eats - Member Favorites

Thai House - inside an actual house! Great plant-based options.

Angie's Diner - consider "cleaning the sink"

La Ranchera Market - grocery store and food counter

Factory Pizzeria - cheap pizza and more

Food Truck Park - vendors vary seasonally

Lucky Slice Pizza - new location, same great pizza. Great plant-based options.

Center Street Pizza - also delicious pizza

Cafe Ibis - coffee, baked goods, etc

Le Croissant - excellent baked goods. Great plant-based options.

Herm's Inn – delicious breakfast and down the hill from the office. Great plant-based options.

Cooks Underground – relatively well priced burgers. Great plant-based options.

Gaia GPS (FREE app):

It cannot be stressed enough how useful this app will/would be to most of you. It is excellent for recording tracks and waypoints which can be useful in saving favorite campsites, hikes, etc. The app also does a great job showing camping areas (specifically dispersed) which you may not find otherwise.

Google Maps:

Satellite view can be very helpful when used in conjunction with other forms of navigation. Often you can even zoom in far enough to get a good idea of a routes surface condition, (slickrock ledges, sand, double track, maintained gravel, etc.) Many wise “no-go” decisions can be made by viewing satellite imagery...ask us how we know...

Why Leave No Trace? LNT involves the “Seven Principles” that we follow to work and recreate outdoors in a sustainable and mindful fashion. This helps conserve and protect many vital resources for you, the environment, and those in the future as well as the past. **Please know these principles for use on and off work hours.**

NOAA and the National Weather Service will provide the most detailed and accurate weather for the area. The weather here is extreme and can range from single digits to triple digits, all forms of precipitation, flash flooding, extreme heat, etc. We encourage you all to be informed and up to date on weather conditions. **Staying informed will ensure your safety as well as those who work in emergency services such as Search and Rescue.**

Fire Restrictions: utahfireinfo.gov/fire-restrictions

Note: Please do not construct new fire rings, use only existing ones. **Do not ever leave fires unattended!** **Always make sure your fire is out and cold!** Mix coals/ash with water and feel for heat by hand.
