Dear Carrie,

The Office of Child Care (OCC) recognizes the important work you are doing caring for Utah children throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. OCC understands that this pandemic has impacted your program and continues to generate uncertainty for you and the families using your services.



As you may know, OCC recently released the Child Care Operations Grant. Beginning this week, this grant is now available to programs operating with a Residential Certificate through Child Care Licensing. This grant provides funds to regulated child care programs throughout the state that are open to ensure that despite lost enrollment, programs have the resources to continue operating. The expenses allowable with these funds are those approved by Congress through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Stability Act (CARES Act) and include payroll, rent, utilities, supplies, materials and expenses related to health and safety requirements, among other expenses.
